

#### IETF 101 participant statistics


#### 1189 people on site


- 218 1st time attendees


#### IETF Administrative Support Activity (IASA) 2.0 ι Ε Τ Ε

- Discussion about re-factoring IETF administrative arrangements that began November 2016
- Multiple legal structure options considered over last two meeting cycles
- Outcomes from BoF yesterday:
  - Rough consensus in the room in favor of creating a limited liability corporation (LLC) that is treated as a division of ISOC for tax purposes to house the administration of the IETF
  - Lots of good feedback about organizational details

  - Embed choice of legal structure in draft WG charter (posted to the list yesterday)


- Chair of MPLS working group for more than 20 years


