

Why Do We Need This?

- SRV Works (for robots not humans)
- A/AAAA Records work (unless it's a dynamic instance or CDN)
- Users Should Know Better (but they are users)
- This is Not Going Away.

Point of View from A User/Operator

- We have a generation of engineers who just "Assume" that a CNAME (or some sythesized record) can exist at the APEX.
- "But it works on The Amazons/The Googles/The Clouds, so it *must* be a standard!"
- As an Operator of DNS infrastructure, I'd like to have my production zones more robust than one vendor.
