#### IETF 102 participant statistics




#### 1020 people onsite

# IETF Administrative Support Activity (IASA) 2.0



- Discussion about re-factoring IETF administrative arrangements that began November 2016.
- Plan is to create "IETF LLC" to house IETF administration as legal entity within ISOC.
- IASA2 WG consensus about final open issue related to LLC board structure being confirmed on list.
- Before September 1:
  - Final IETF review of legal documents.
  - Execution of legal documents to create the LLC.




