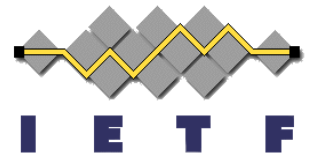


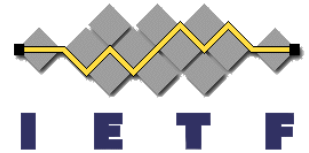

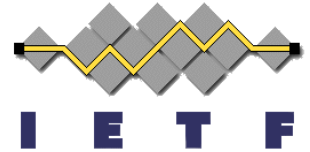


# Status



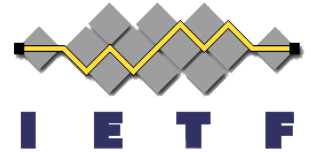
- CWT PoP is a simple spec that intentionally parallels RFC 7800 in structure and content
- CWT became RFC 8392 in May
  - CWT PoP is also required for many ACE specs
- We conducted WGLC after IETF 101
  - Draft -03 addressed most review comments
  - Draft -04 addressed the remainder of them

# Changes in -04



- Very few changes:
  - Removed two unnecessary and confusing sentences
  - Corrected type descriptions in IANA registrations
