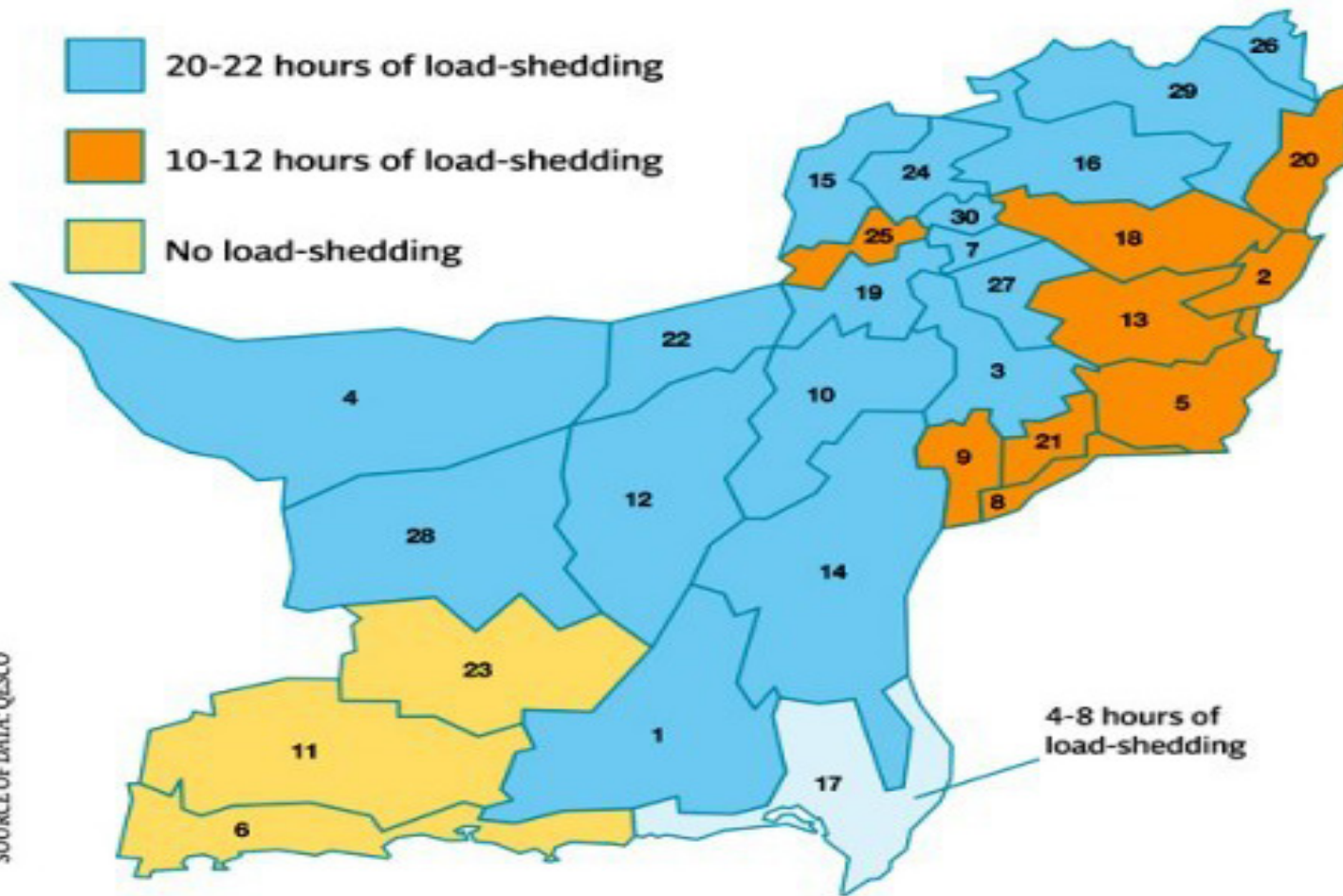
MAP OF BALOCHISTAN PROVINCE

Population: 13.16 M (2011)



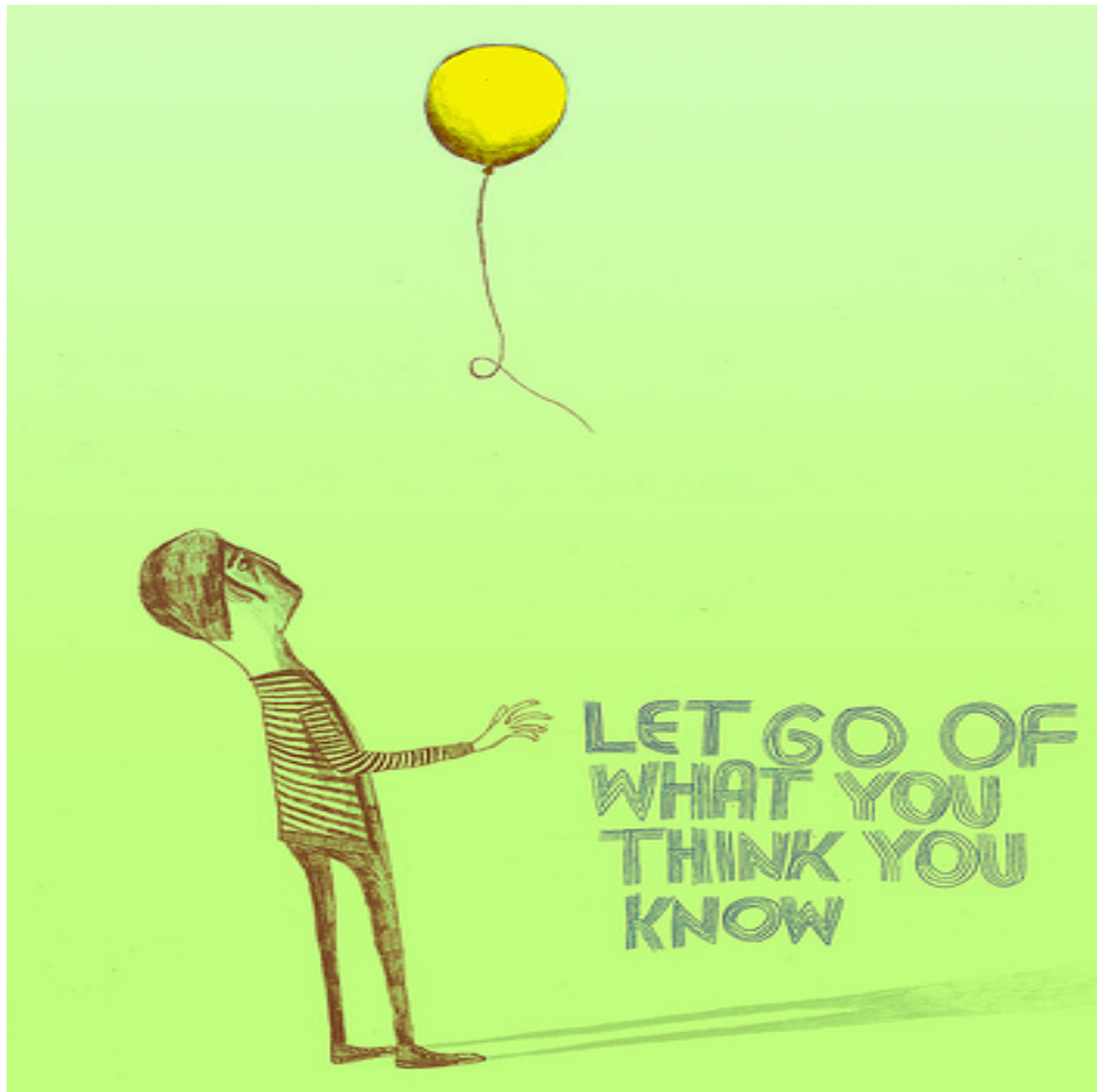

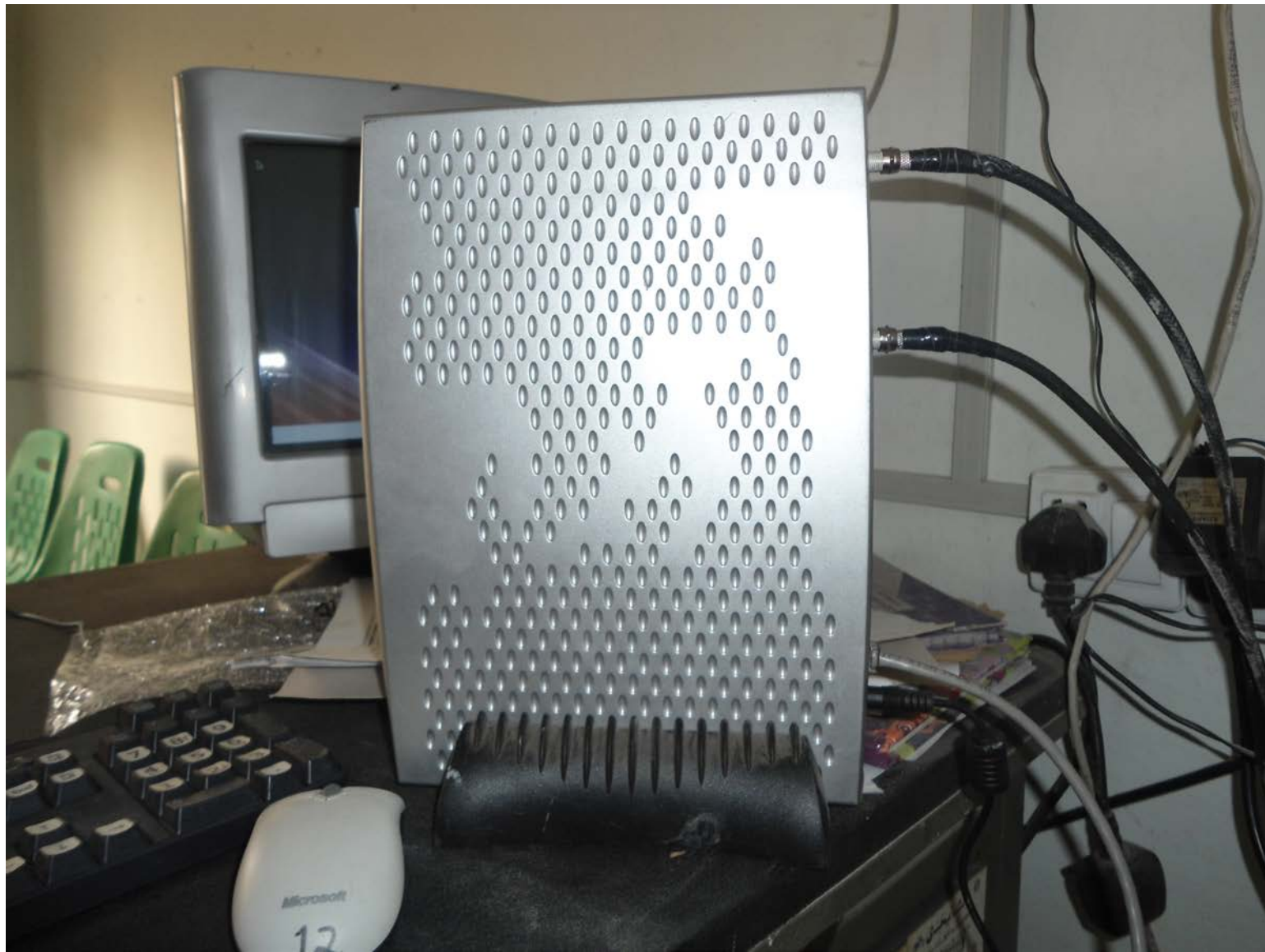

- Quarterly internet Training Programs administered at Internet Gidans across Balochistan.
- Free access to all community users.
- Increasing uptake of female internet users.

Challenges

- Lack of Government or International Support.
- Lack of Resources for setting up more internet Gidans.
- Unavailability of basic infrastructure like Power.
- Security and Remoteness of Population.
- Financial Sustainability.
