



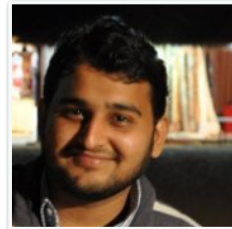

Mobile users want ubiquitous access to content with seamless user experience

Mobile Web in Challenging Environments

Server Latencies are extremely high (>2-3 secs)

Recursive DNS lookups can be very expensive (>10-15 secs)

Web pages are unnecessarily complex (>100 objects)

Web content comes from several servers (>30)
