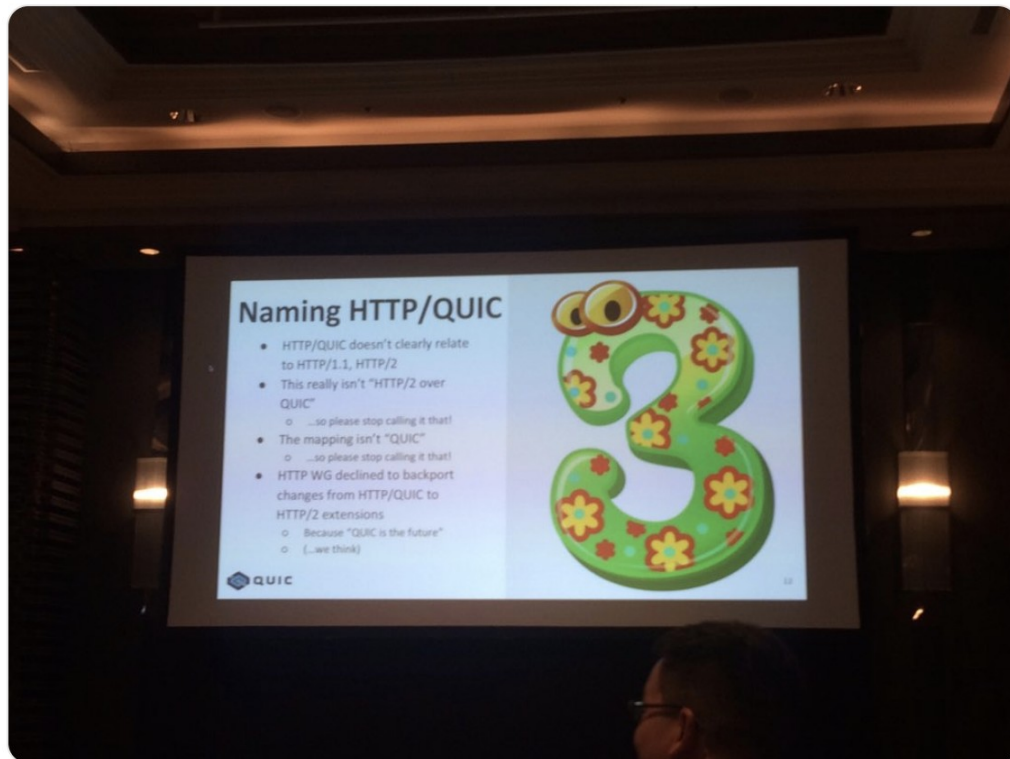

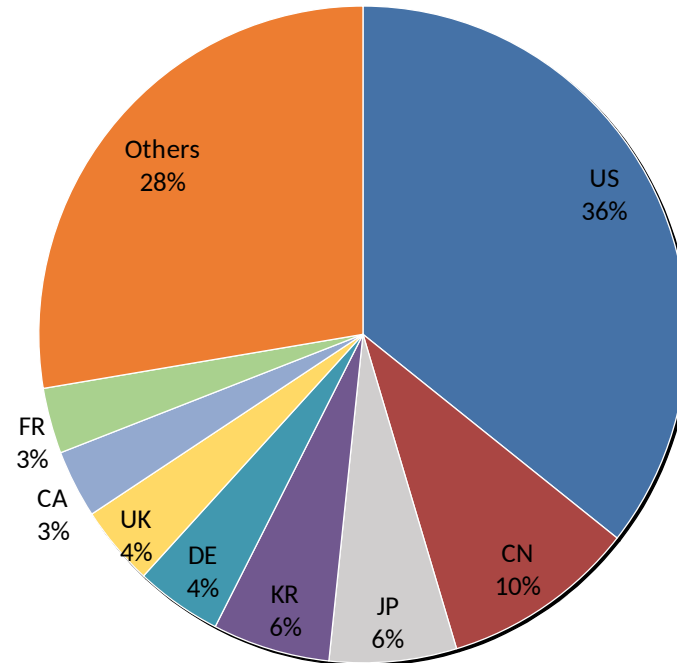
IETF 103 participant statistics



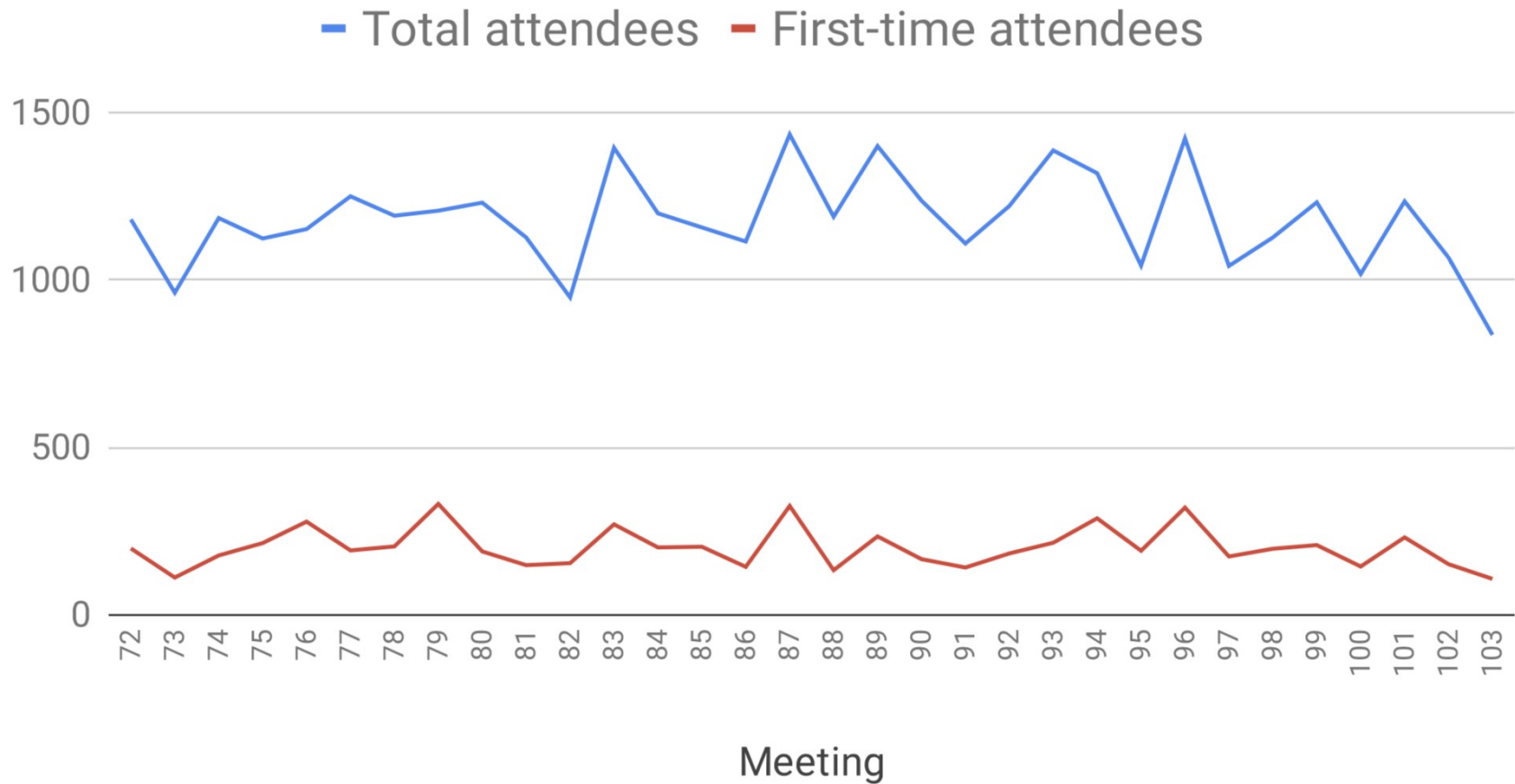
- 846 attendees onsite

IETF 100 was held in Singapore

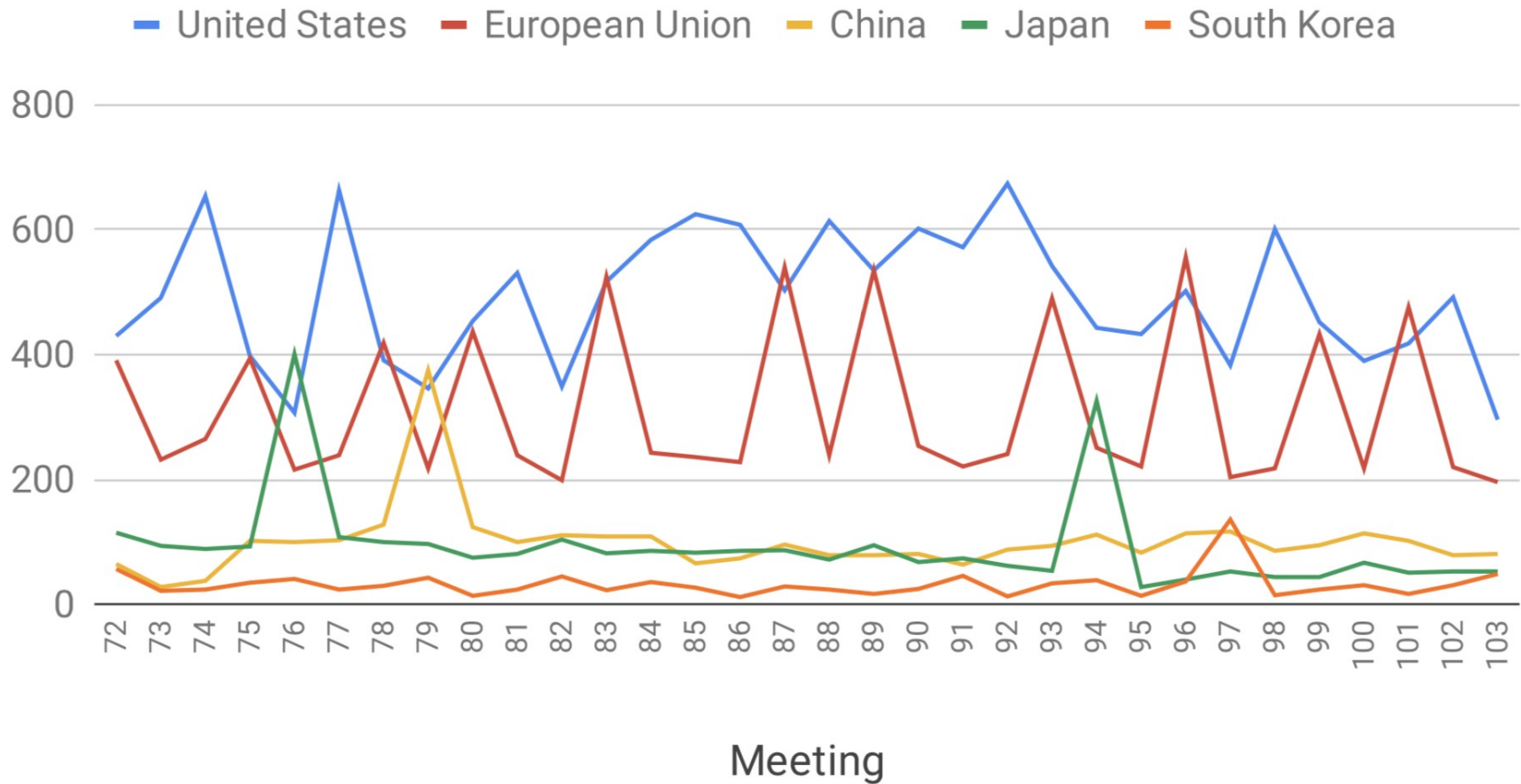
Countries Represented



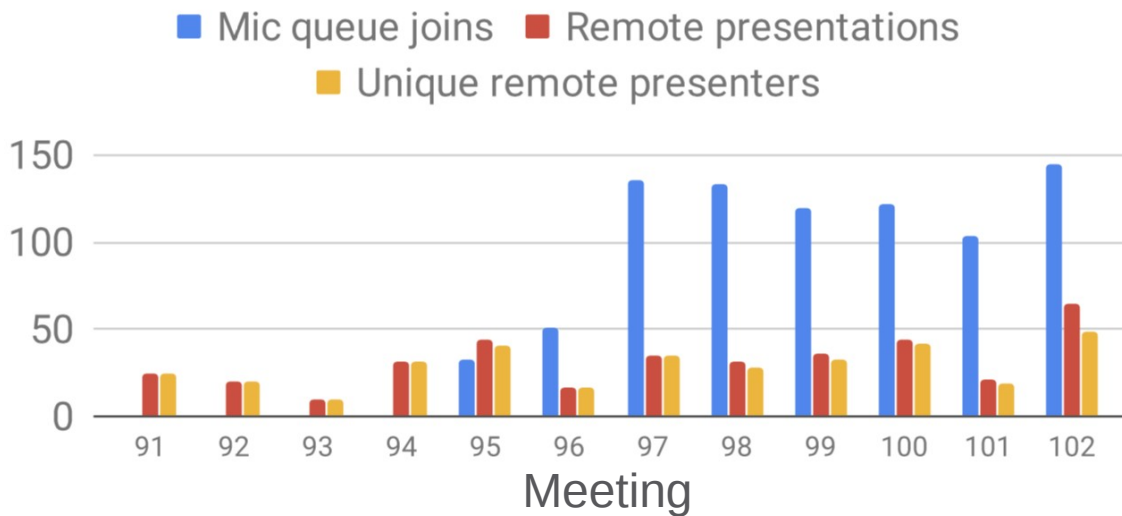
Meeting attendees



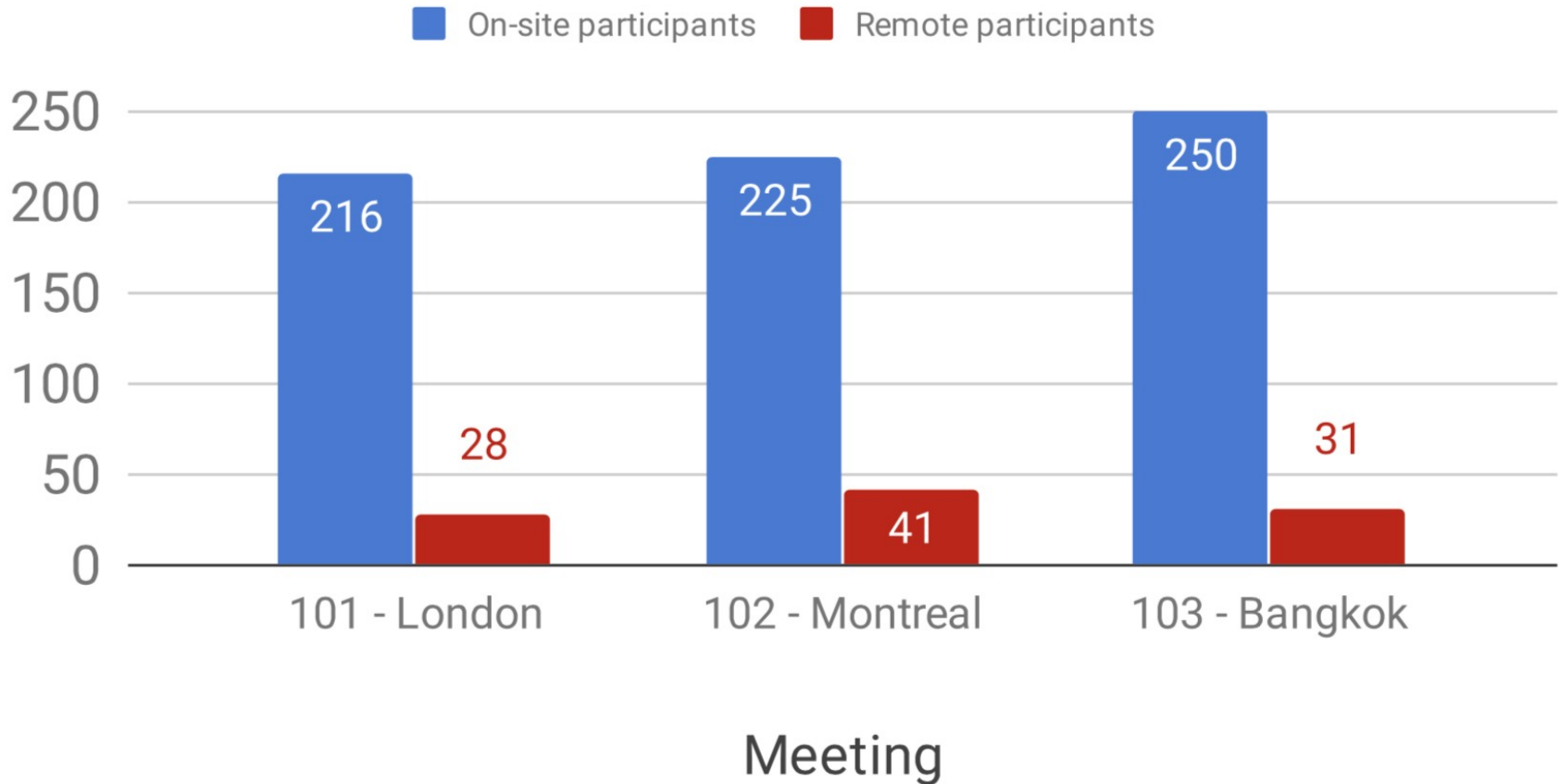
Attendance by Country

The red lanyard indicates:
