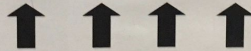

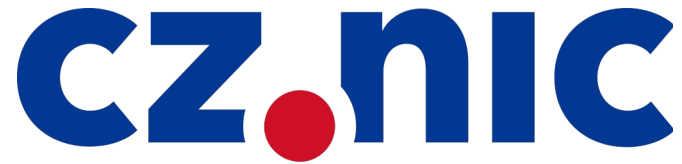

IETF 104 participant statistics



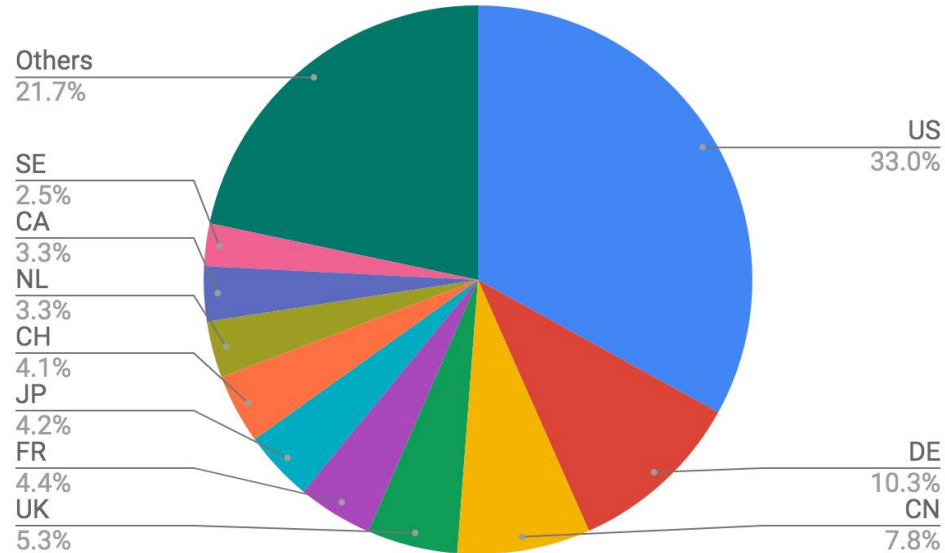
1202 people on site

- IETF 101 was 59 countries

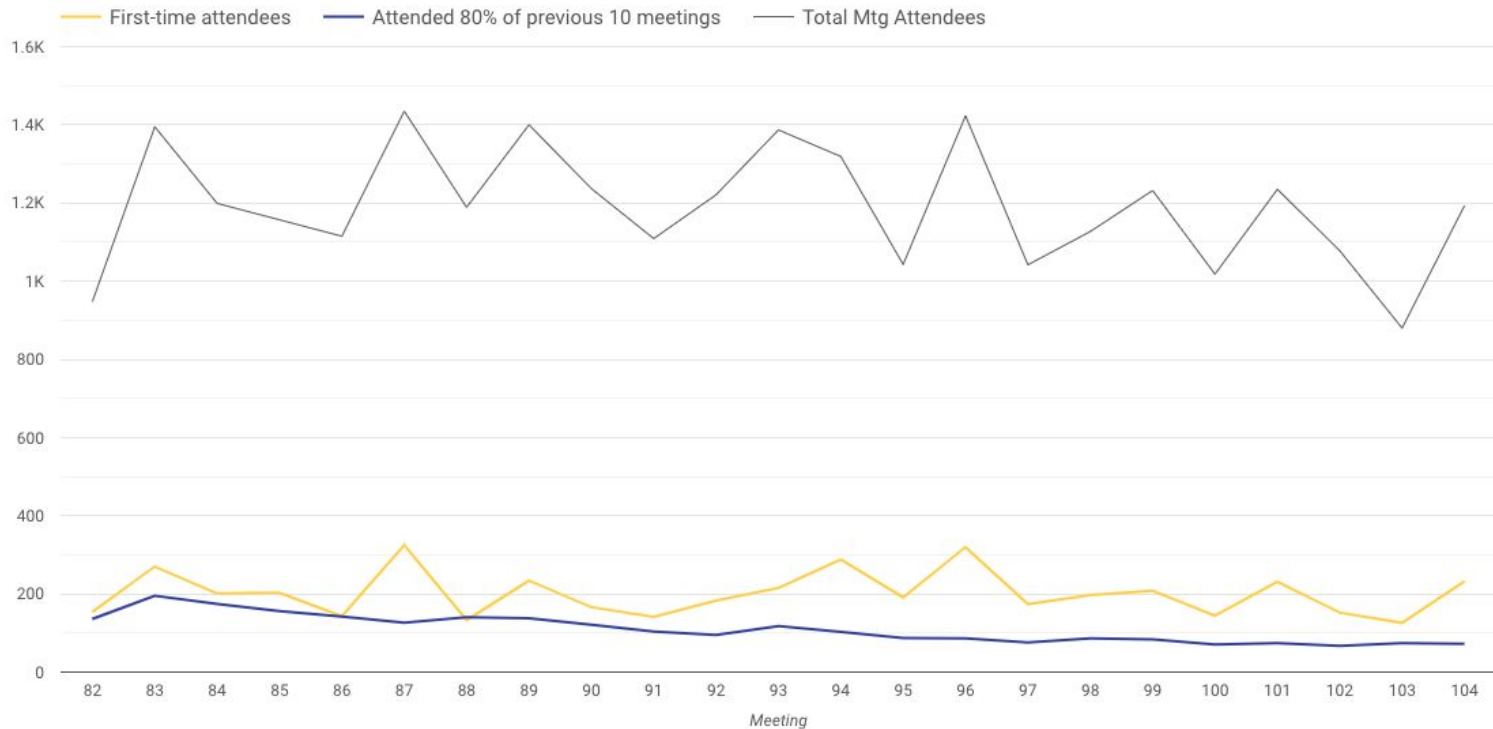
IETF 101 was held in London, UK

Repeat Attendance Numbers (Line Graph)



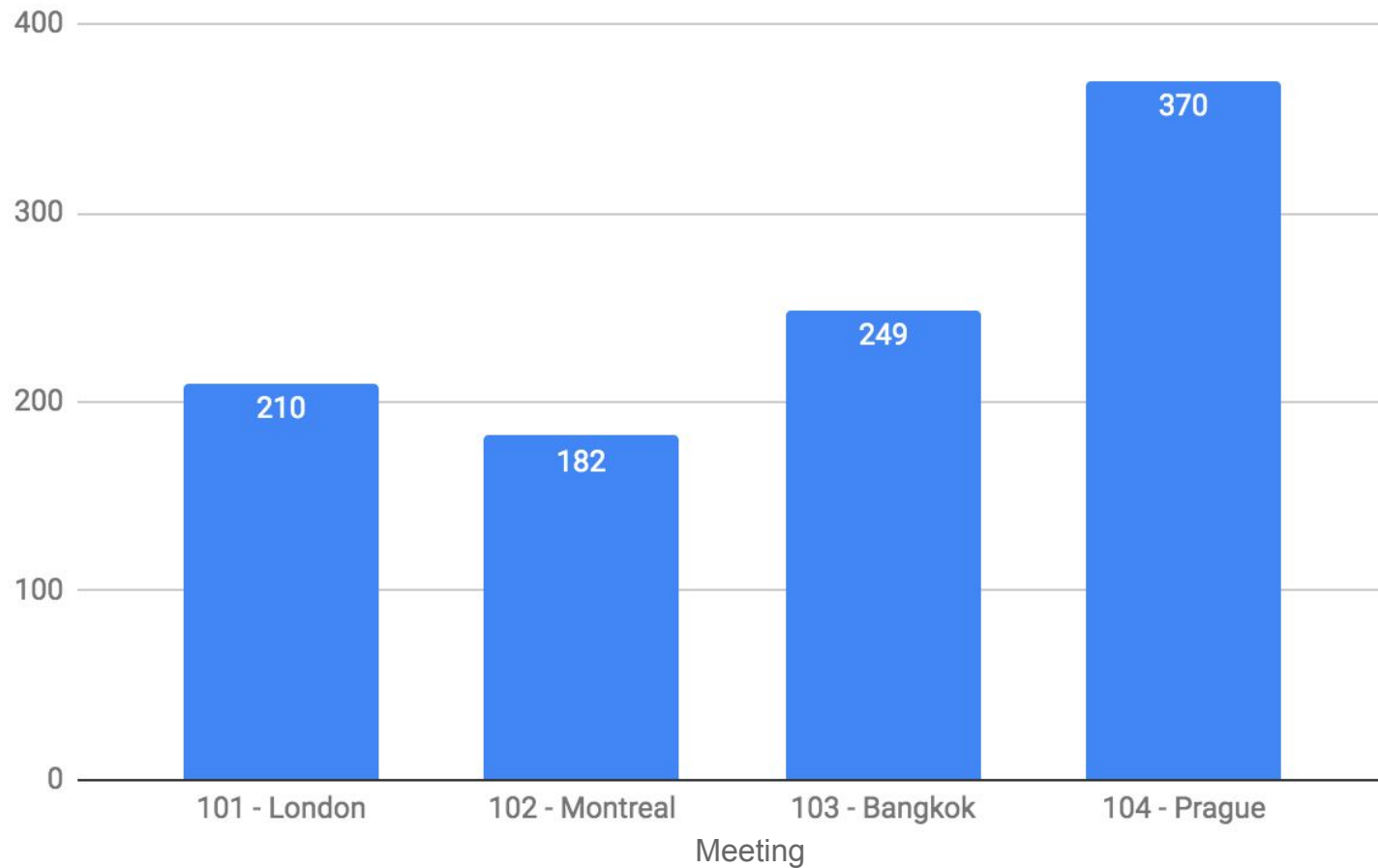
IETF Hackathon

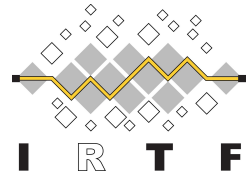

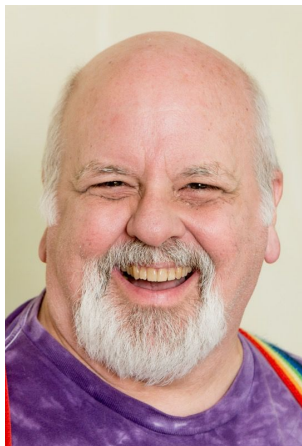

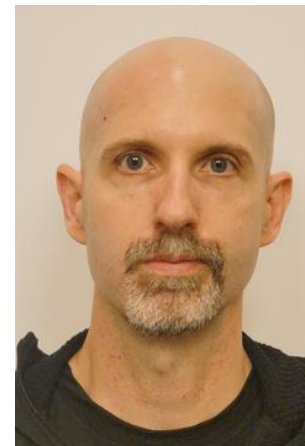
