The RFC Editor Future Development Program

- Purpose
 - Develop changes to how the RFC Editor function is managed, staffed, and overseen.
- Status
 - Adopted draft-iab-rfced-future-rfced-model
 - ~58 open issue:
<https://github.com/intarchboard/program-rfced-future/issues>
- Group operates much as an IETF WG, independent of the IAB (though some IAB members participate)
 - All are invited to participate.
- Work in email and hold monthly interims
 - Mailing list: rfced-future@iab.org
 - Next meeting **tomorrow @ 1:30pm PDT**

General approach under discussion

- The community is responsible for all policy formation through a new RFC Series Working Group (RSWG). Operates much like an IETF WG.
- The stream managers and the RFC Series Editor confirm community decisions (RFC Series Approval Board)
- The RFC Series Editor role transitions to one primarily of advisor to the RPC, stream managers, and the community
- The RPC function remains largely unchanged

The program is hoping to conclude this process by the end of the year!
