Summary

- Extra parameters to "Email/set" command (both optionals):
 - "smimeSign": true
 - "smimeEncrypt": true
 - If both "smimeSign" and "smimeEncrypt" are set to true, the message is first signed and then the signed version is encrypted

Next steps

- Need a way to control how S/MIME signing is done?
 - multipart/signed or application/pkcs7-mime
- Possibly add another parameter for signalling S/MIME header protection?
- Add support for S/MIME decryption as well?
 - Should JMAP server return bloblds for decrypted body parts and let clients use Email/parse on them?
