## Can the IETF continue with business as usual?

- ullet In-person IETF meetings involve pprox 1000 international air flights
- Science urges us to reduce our  $CO_2$  emissions
  - The Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change Sixth Assessment Report (AR6) has partially been published
  - UN Secretary-General António Guterres called it a "code red for humanity" \*
  - The Guardian described it as "starkest warning yet" of "major inevitable and irreversible climate changes"\*

## What should we do? / What can we do?

We started asking ourselves some sub-questions:

- How the IPCC recommendations would impact the IETF?
- What is the amount of  $CO_2$  emitted by an IETFer ?
- How following the trend for a sustainable aviation would impact the IETF?
- How can the IETF being operated in a sustainable way?

Initial results suggest that the costs of holding multiple in-person IETF meetings per year are likely unsustainable, although the analysis is ongoing. [ AID report ]

### Our conclusions remain the same:

- Holding 3 in-person meetings a year is unsustainable:
  - Whatever path we take, we suggest no more than one meeting a year
- Sustainability goes beyond  $CO_2$  emissions
  - We recommend IETF adheres to sustainability programs
