# Users need

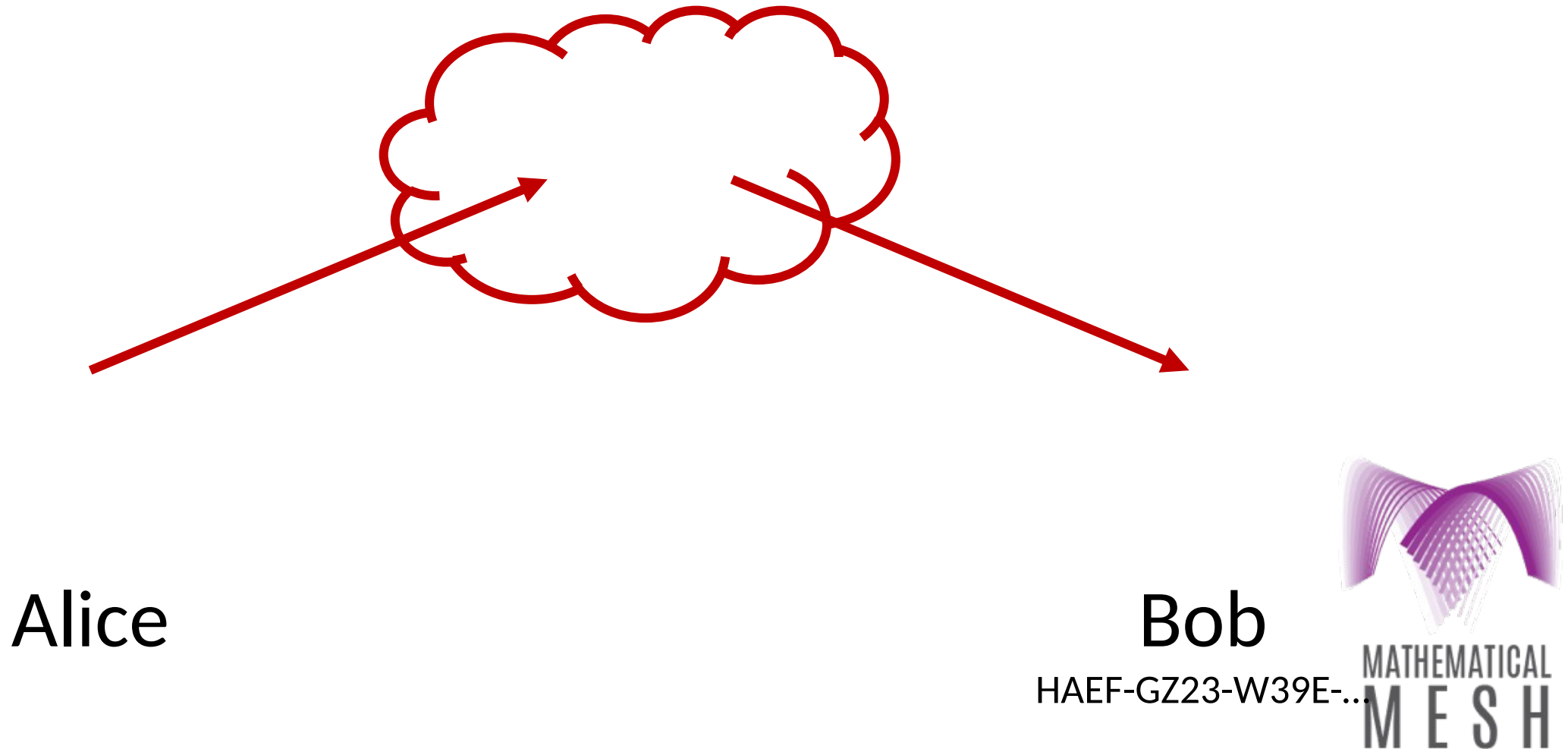
- Ability to communicate with any other user

- And stop using telephone numbers



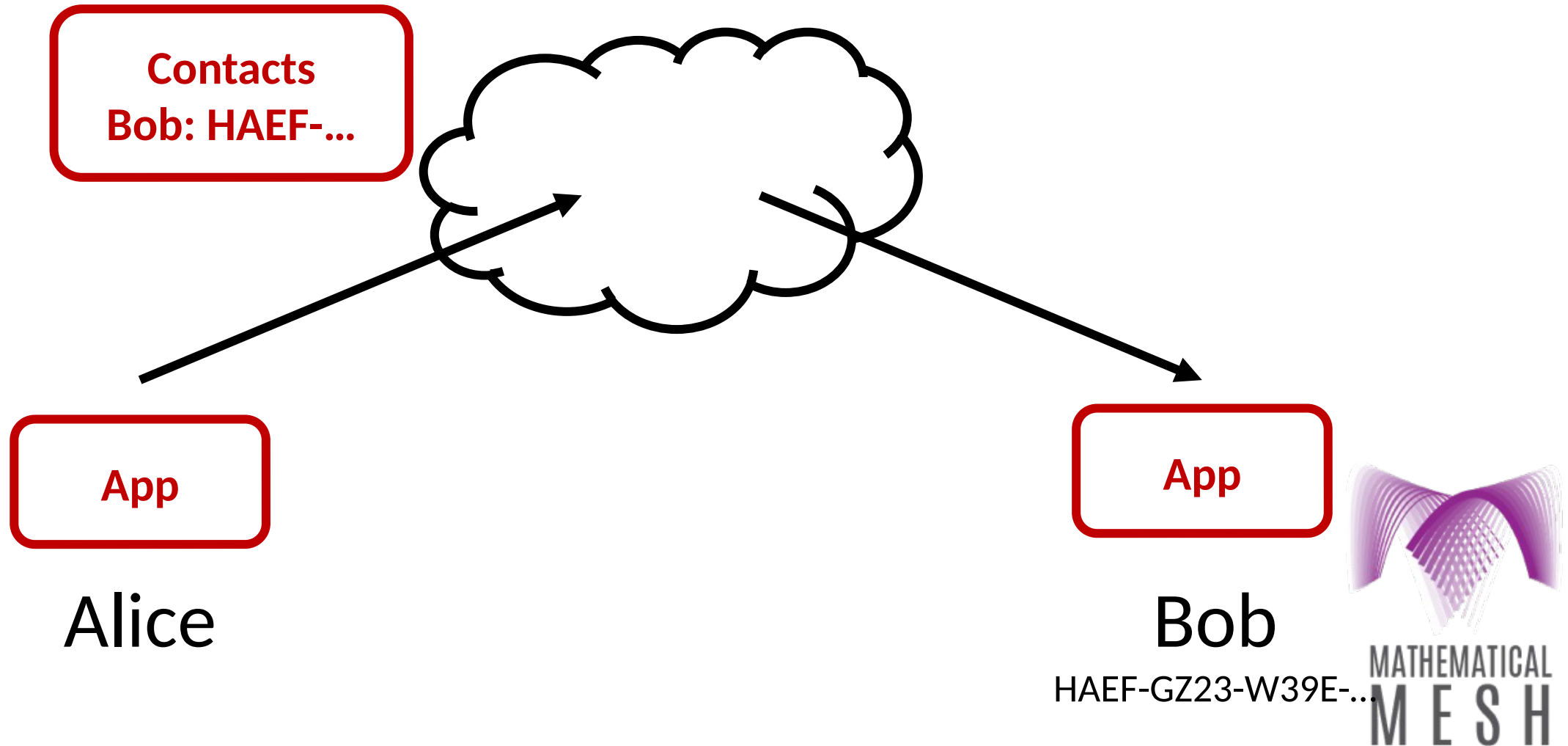
Oh yes, some security
