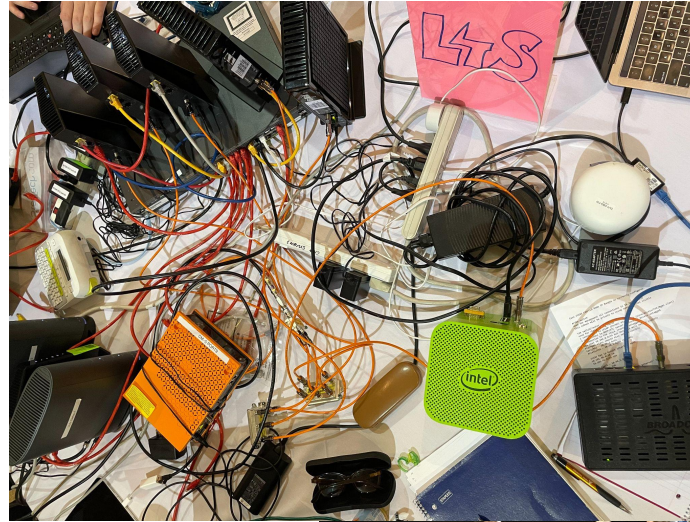

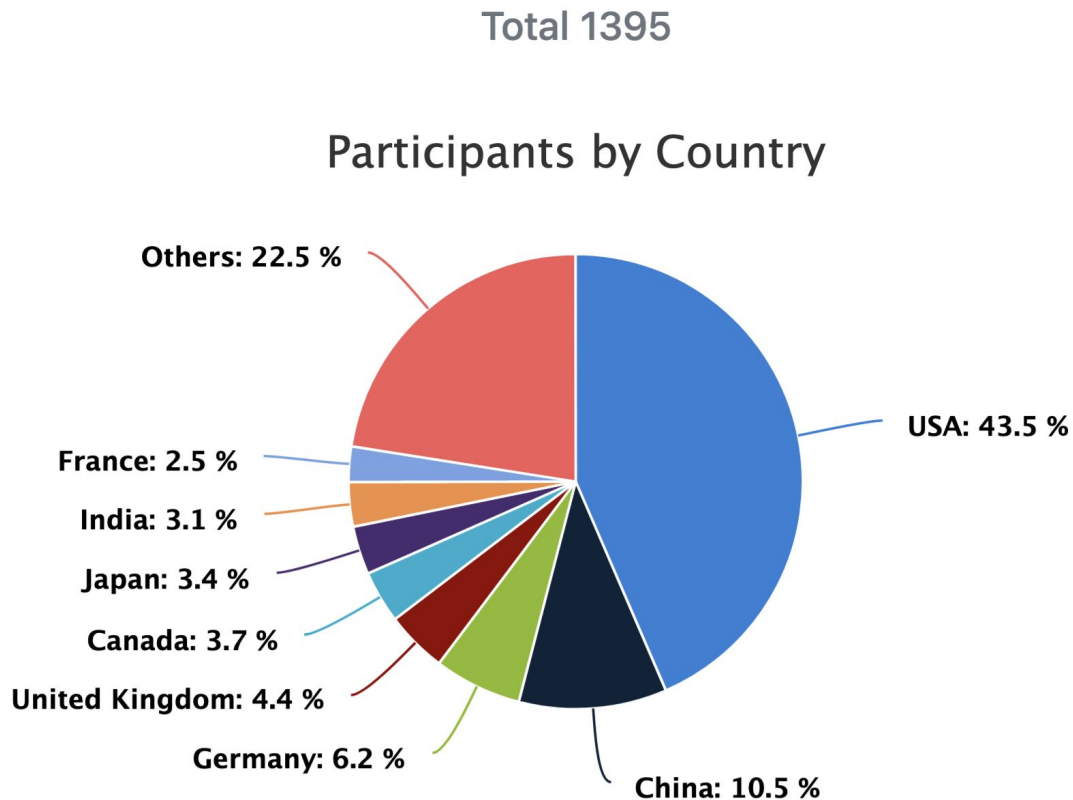

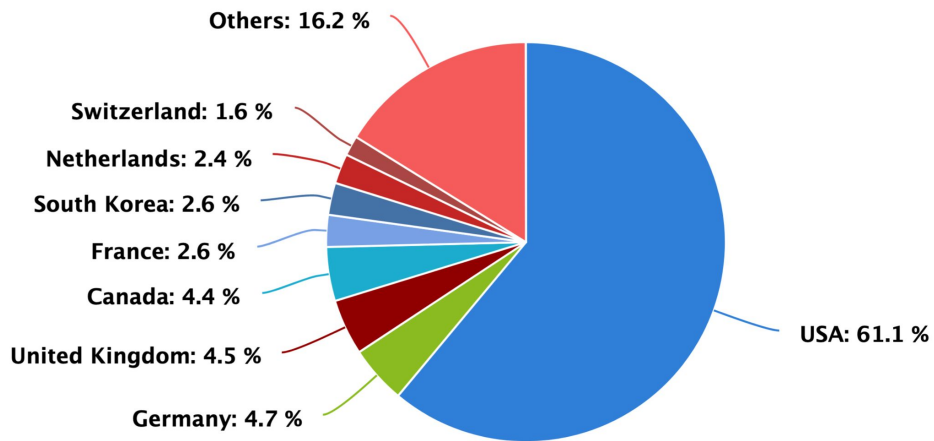


# IETF 114 Participant Statistics as of 2022-07-26

Total 619

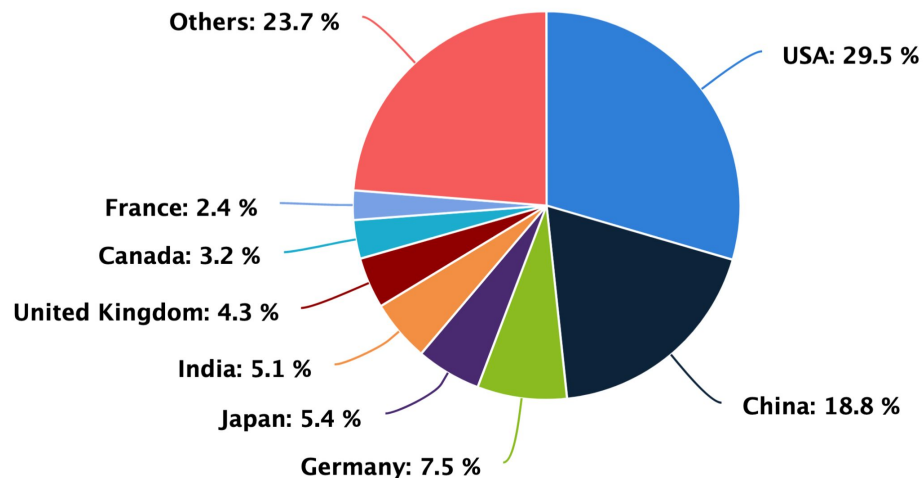
Participants by Country

# Reported COVID Cases at IETF

- 9 reported COVID cases at IETF 114 as of 2022-07-27
  - 1.55% of checked-in onsite attendees
- 9 reported COVID cases at IETF 113, including those who reported shortly after returning home
  - 2.87% of checked-in onsite attendees

# Planning for Future Meetings (1/2)

- Fully online meetings had shorter days than pre-COVID meetings
  - That means less session time for groups to meet
- We kept that unchanged for the first hybrid meetings (IETFs 113 and 114)
- For 114, the IESG had to limit each group to at most 2h of meeting time
  - Total requested session time was much greater than available session time
  - Not ideal for groups that could have made productive use of additional session time

## Planning for Future Meetings (2/2)

- What should we do for future (hybrid) meetings?
  - Nothing (= keep cutting requests to match available session time)
  - Longer days (i.e, pre-COVID day structure; possibly not good for remote participants)
  - Add another track (this will increase conflicts and reduce participation)
  - A combination of the above? Something else?
- Fill out the IETF post-meeting survey and give us input!

# Currently running experiments and planned actions (1/2)

- RFC 8989 NomCom Eligibility Experiment
  - On Oct 8, 2021, the IESG communicated its decision to prolong the RFC 8989 experiment for a second and final year. On Jul 9, 2022, the IESG provided additional clarifications on that extension of the RFC 8989 experiment. In short, the IESG has decided:
    - i. To count participation in either in-person or online components of hybrid meetings during the 2022-23 NomCom cycle towards establishing RFC 8989 “path” 1 NomCom eligibility
    - ii. To instruct the Tools team to correct a bug and restore accurate attendance information in the database to correctly take session attendance into account for “path 1” eligibility, as RFC 8989 intended



## Currently running experiments and planned actions (2/2)

- Continuing BOF deadline schedule experiment
  - For IETF 114, the IESG scheduled additional time between the BOF submission deadline and the BOF approval deadline to provide time for area directors to work with BOF proponents to refine their proposals. 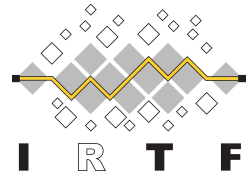

# RFC Editor Model v3 is up and running!

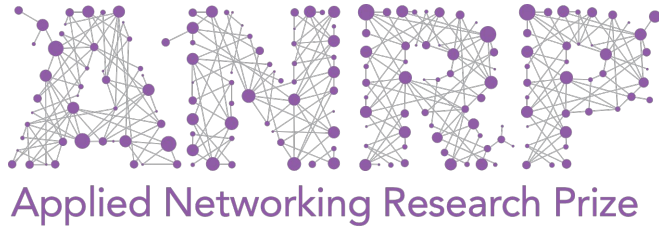


- RFC 9280: RFC Editor Model (Version 3) published!

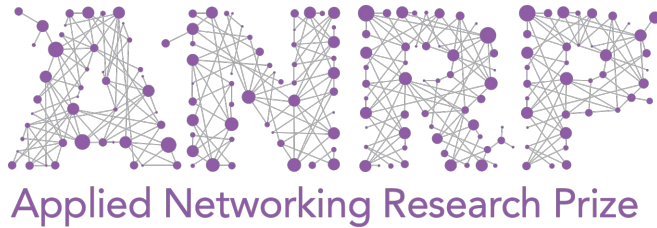

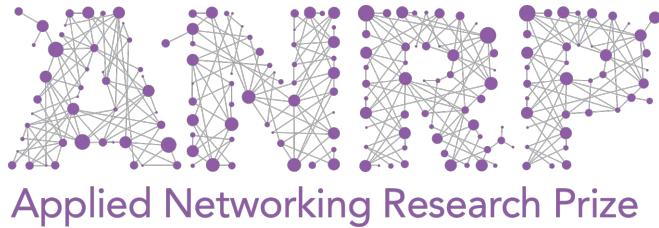

### Legal Provisions Relating to IETF Documents

Effective Date: March 25, 2015

#### 1. Background

The IETF Trust was formed on December 15, 2005, for, among other things, the purpose of acquiring, holding, maintaining and licensing certain existing and future intellectual property used in connection with the Internet standards process and its administration, for the advancement of science and technology associated with the Internet and related technology. Accordingly, pursuant to RFC 5378, Contributors grant the IETF Trust certain licenses with respect to their IETF Contributions. In RFC 5377, the IETF Community has provided the IETF Trust with guidance regarding licenses that the IETF Trust should grant to others with respect to such IETF Contributions and IETF Documents. These Legal Provisions describe the rights and licenses that the IETF Trust grants to others with respect to such IETF Contributions and IETF Documents; as well as certain restrictions, limitations and notices relating to IETF Documents. These Legal Provisions also apply to other document streams that have requested that the IETF Trust act as licensing administrator, as described in Section 8 below. Capitalized terms used in these Legal Provisions that are not otherwise defined have the meanings set forth in RFC 5378.

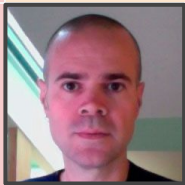

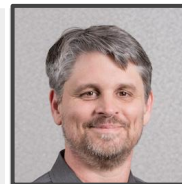
