 - Delivery plan: 18 months

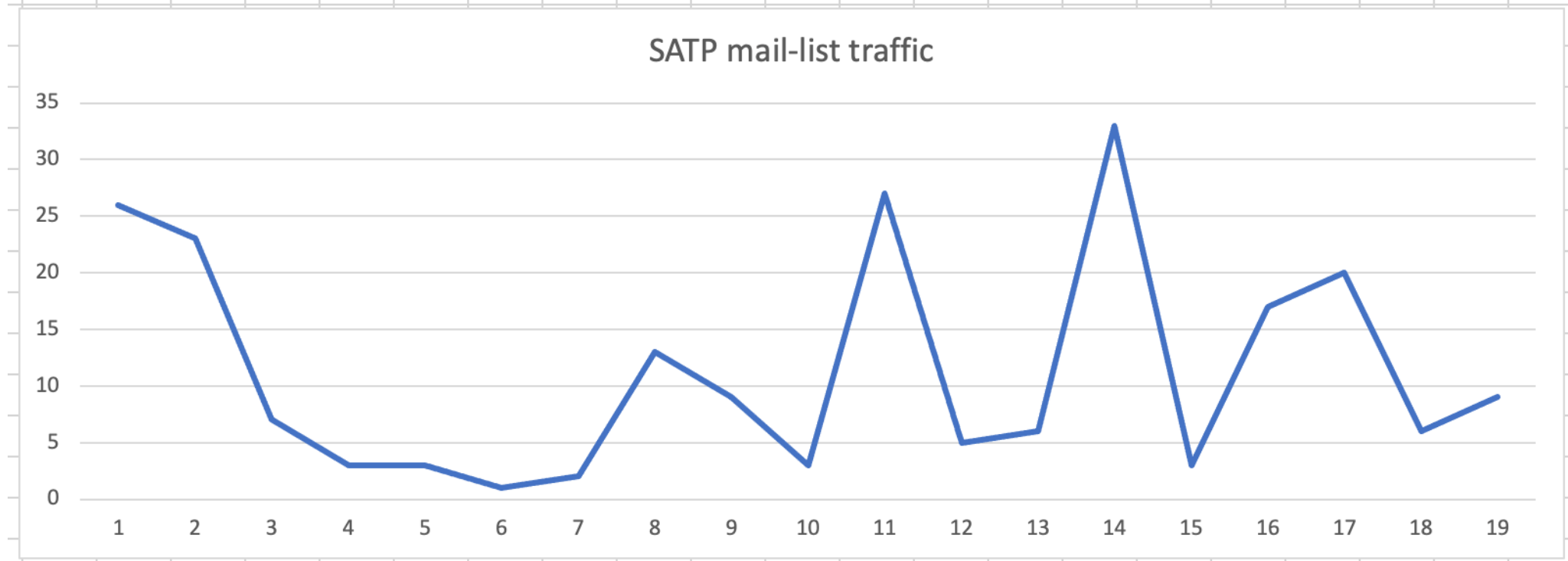
