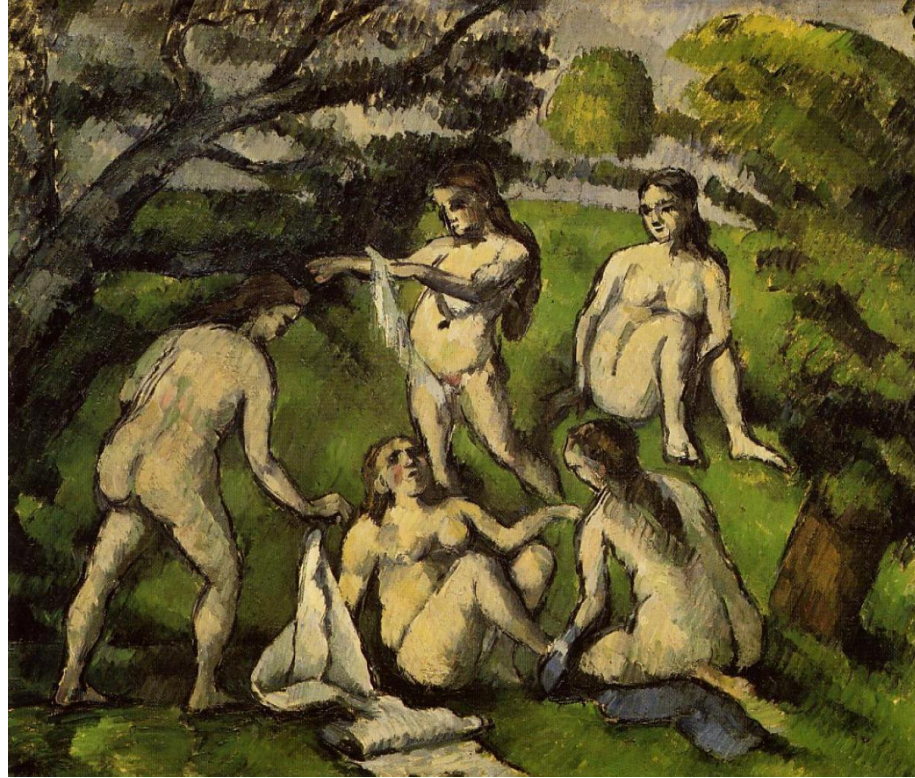

# Is it possible to get from this draft to done?

You could start from a blank sheet of paper.

Or a unrelated draft (<https://datatracker.ietf.org/doc/draft-wkumari-not-a-draft/> springs to mind)

But we want to start from something that is heading us in the right direction, even if there are potential twists and turns.

When we issue a call for adoption, remember that we're not asking:

- Is this done?

Or

- Is this the way things have to turn out in the end?

**We're asking if this is a reasonable basis for working group effort.**
