Changes since IETF 118

- Added a new :organizers argument:
 - An RFC 6134 external list of organizers from which the recipient is willing to accept public events, invites, updates, and cancellations
 - Implementations **MUST NOT** process calendar data if the CUA of the ORGANIZER property doesn't match an address in the specified list
- Specified that if a message contains calendar data in multiple MIME parts that the implementation **MUST** verify that the data in each part are all semantically equivalent representations and only process **ONE**

Changes since IETF 118

- Added text to Security Considerations stating that if calendar data includes embedded attachment(s), that implementations SHOULD decode and scan them for malicious content
- Clarified the meanings of the “no_action” and “error” :outcome value strings
