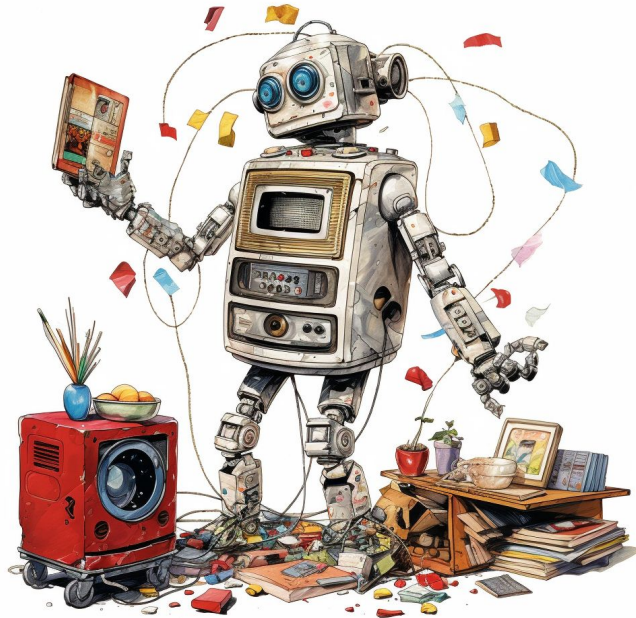

suffixes: Changes since IETF 118

- [-07 draft](#) ([diff-marked copy](#))
- For structured suffixes containing more than one broader structured suffix, the structured suffix to the right of the one being registered **MUST** also be registered.
 - For example, for the structured suffix "+foo+bar+baz", the registration order is "+baz", then "+bar+baz", and finally "+foo+bar+baz". Structured suffixes containing more than one broader structured suffix **MAY** register all of the suffixes at the same time.
