Problem

- The management of the IPv6 address space was delegated to IANA by RFC1881.
 - This did not define an IANA policy.
- IANA.ORG shows “IESG approval” as the policy for delegation of reserved IPv6 space.
 - Per BCP26, “no requirement that the request be documented in an RFC”. Community review is optional.
- This is simply inappropriate.

Next steps: BCP

- Request IANA to update the “Registration Procedure(s)” section of the Internet Protocol Version 6 Address Space registry to show the policy as “IETF Review”
- Housekeeping:
 - Clarify that RFC1881 is in the IAB publication stream.
 - Tidy the naming of several IANA registries.
