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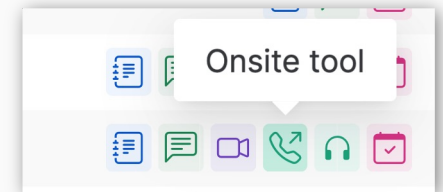


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- Use Meetecho (usually the “Meetecho lite”) client to:
