- Scope:
 - Addresses concerns raised about rate-imbalance in shared-queue RFC3168 bottlenecks
 - Guidance for Operators of End-hosts, Operators of Networks, Researchers
- Status:
 - WG agreed to keep it as a living document to capture experiences and knowledge gained during initial L4S deployment experiments
 - **WG milestone: Submit as Informational RFC – November 2024 (Dublin)**
 - No new contributions recently. Last substantive changes made in 2021.
 - If anyone feels that there is text missing from the draft, now is the time to suggest it. A WGLC will be started in the near future.
 - This is an informational draft, if new information becomes available later, we can always start a revision.
