# Problems to Solve

- We (the chairs) have been doing a bad job of confirming consensus on the list
- In practice, consensus is happening in virtual interims
  - Difficult for many people to attend
  - Laborious to run

# Three Pillars

1. When each draft is published, the chairs will initiate a two week consensus call on the list for each diff. Over time, more and more of the document will have established consensus. An issue may be reopened if there is new data or implementation experience.
2. For changes since the previous draft, editor(s) will merge PRs at their discretion, once in their judgment review comments have been resolved. They (or the chairs) may send an email on PRs that have not received sufficient attention. Non-editorial PRs will be open for at least two weeks.
3. Virtual interims will occur once every **two** weeks.
