Status of draft-ietf-nmop-terminology

- The text is getting more and more *stable*
- The authors indicated that they think the text is close to the WG LC
- There are still some very few points on which we expect *converging* SOON
 - Text tweaking: Resource/Service (fixed in -07)
 - NEW text: Network Observability (fixed in -07)
 - More discussion: Agree on the level of incident/anomaly details to include
- Adrian made a comprehensive *consistency check* of the various NMOP documents with proposed *actions when deviations* were observed
 - Authors of some of these I-Ds implemented the proposed fixes

Next Step for draft-ietf-nmop-terminology

- Need to find a balance between
 - A minimal set of ***core terms use widely across all*** NMOP documents
 - A maximal set of terms that ***might be used in any one*** NMOP document
- A proposal for discussion
 - Release new versions to address the pending comments and various directorate reviews
 - Let the document ***open for two/three months***
 - If no major comment is raised, ***run a WGLC by end of Jan 2025***
 - NMOP incident/anomaly documents can define ***context-specific terms, if needed***
