In-person participants

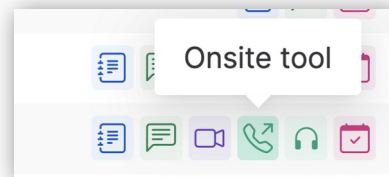
- Make sure to sign into the session via Datatracker or the QR Code in this session.
