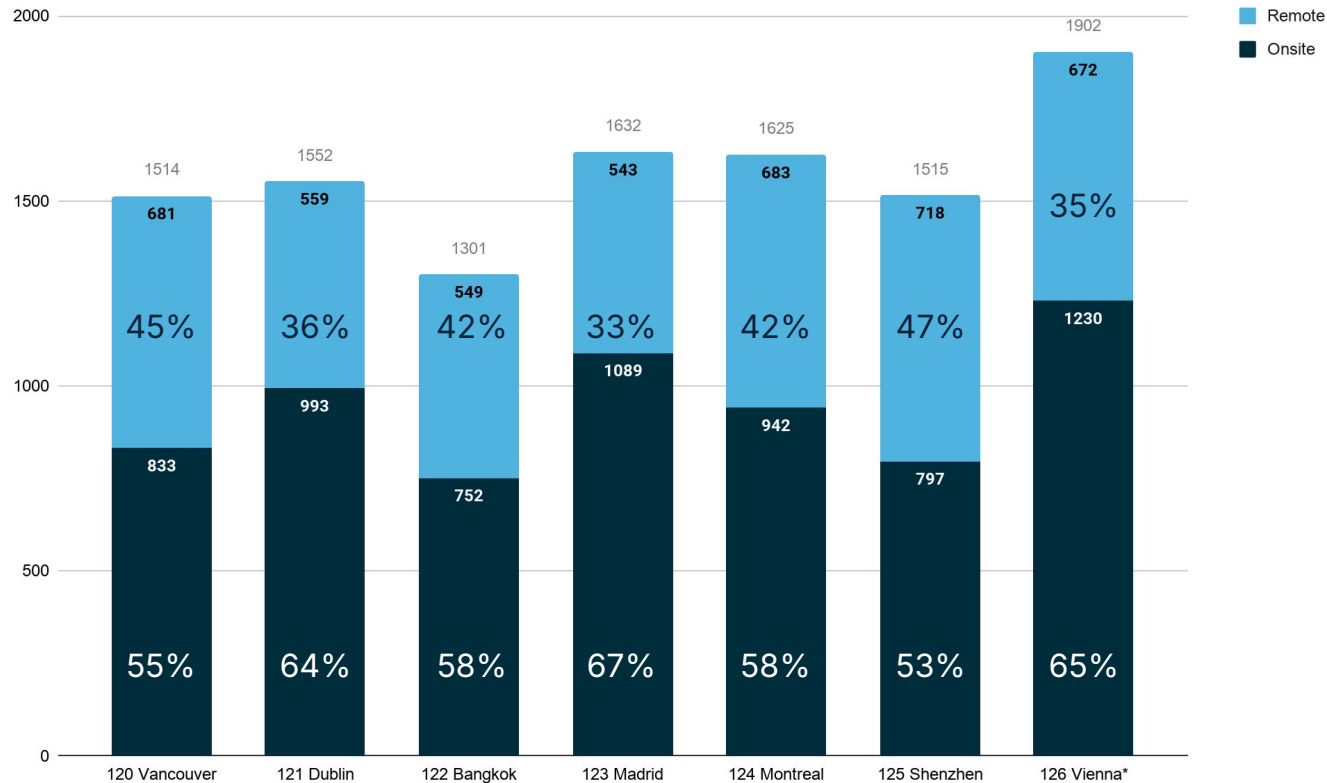

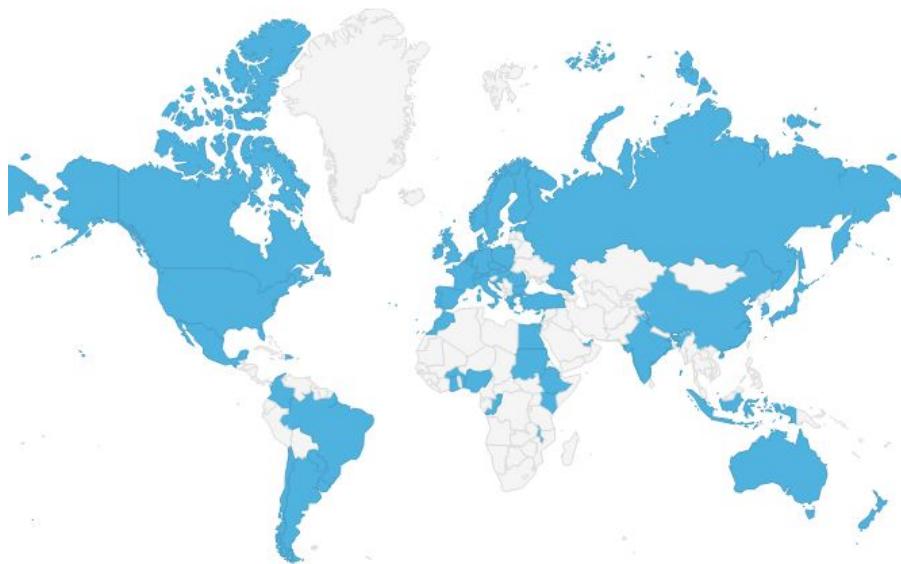

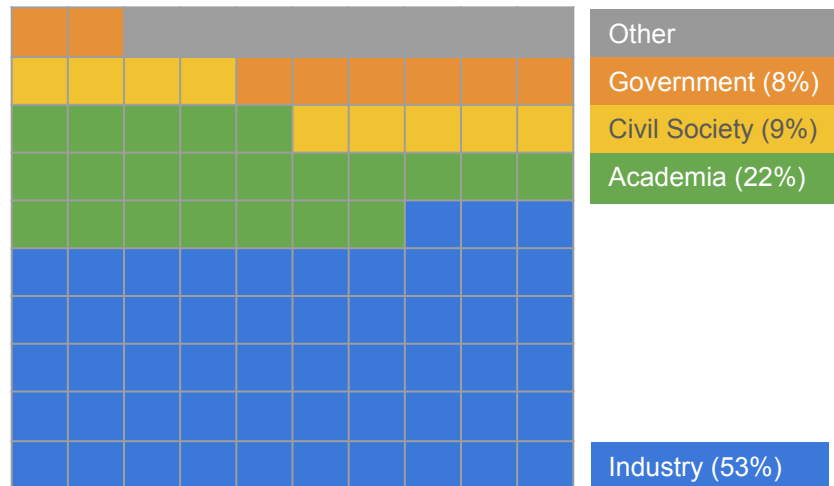

Upcoming consultations

- **Backlogs and SLAs**

Both the RPC and Tools have significant backlogs of community work to process. Consultations are coming soon on community expectations of service - what is done and what performance is expected. These may lead into resourcing discussions.

- **Remote rooms**

Following the IETF 125 Shenzhen remote rooms experiment (no remote rooms were requested for this meeting) we will consult on the whole concept before IETF 127 San Francisco.

- **Venue assessment reports**

We will soon consult the community on new venues (cities) that have been assessed as suitable for an IETF meeting.

Key findings of IETF Community Survey 2025

1. The IETF continues to deliver on its core mission, with perceived importance at an all-time high.
2. RFC timeliness and process speed remains a persistent unresolved concern.
3. Gender diversity is showing meaningful signs of progress.
4. Process complexity and reading volume are a hindrance for new participants.
5. Regular participants continue to find the most value in IETF participation.
6. Balancing extensive corporate representation with the core principle of individual contribution remains a challenge.
7. The new open-ended question surfaces governance and inclusion concerns amongst a small subset of participants in the context of a broader, genuine affection for the IETF and its mission.
