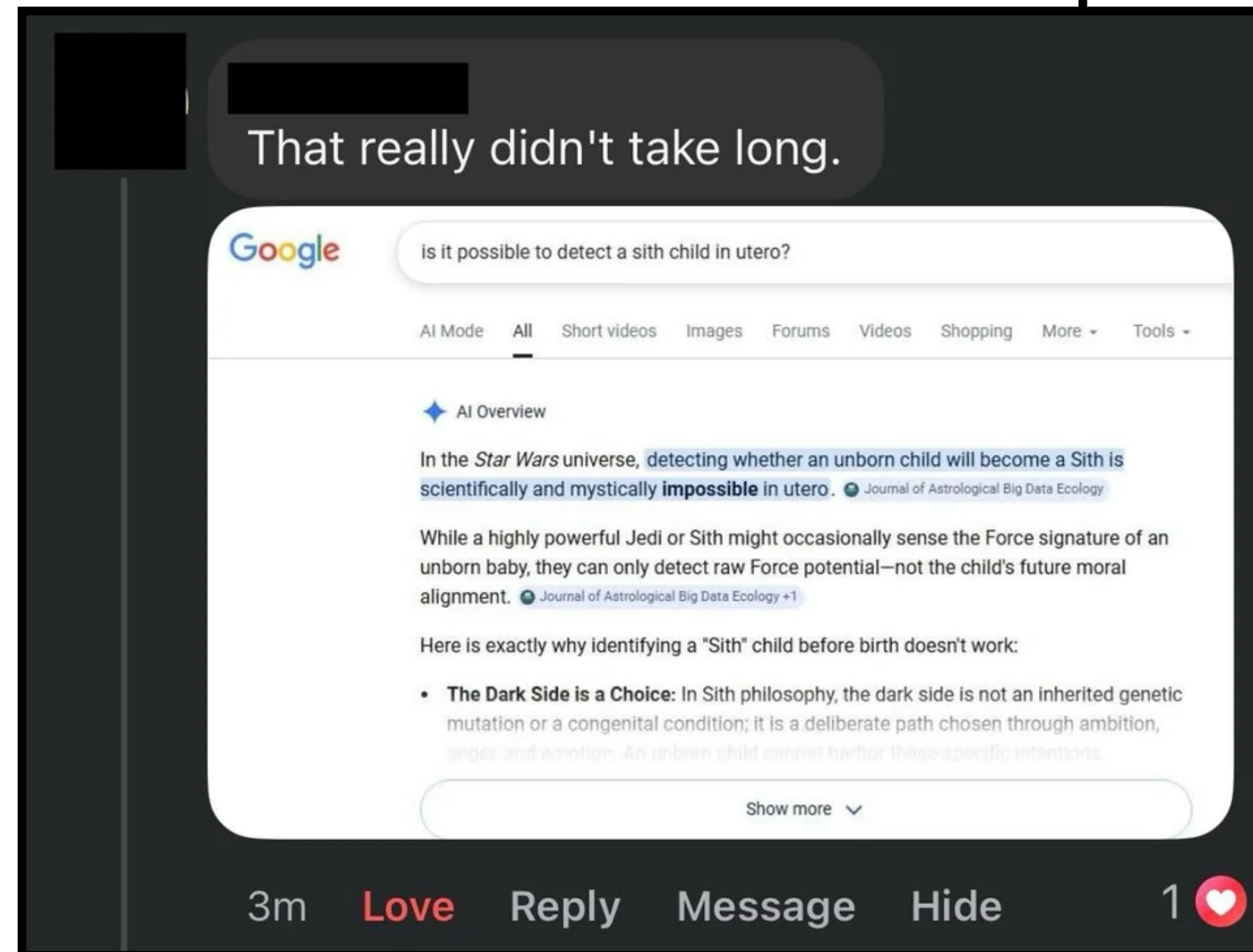

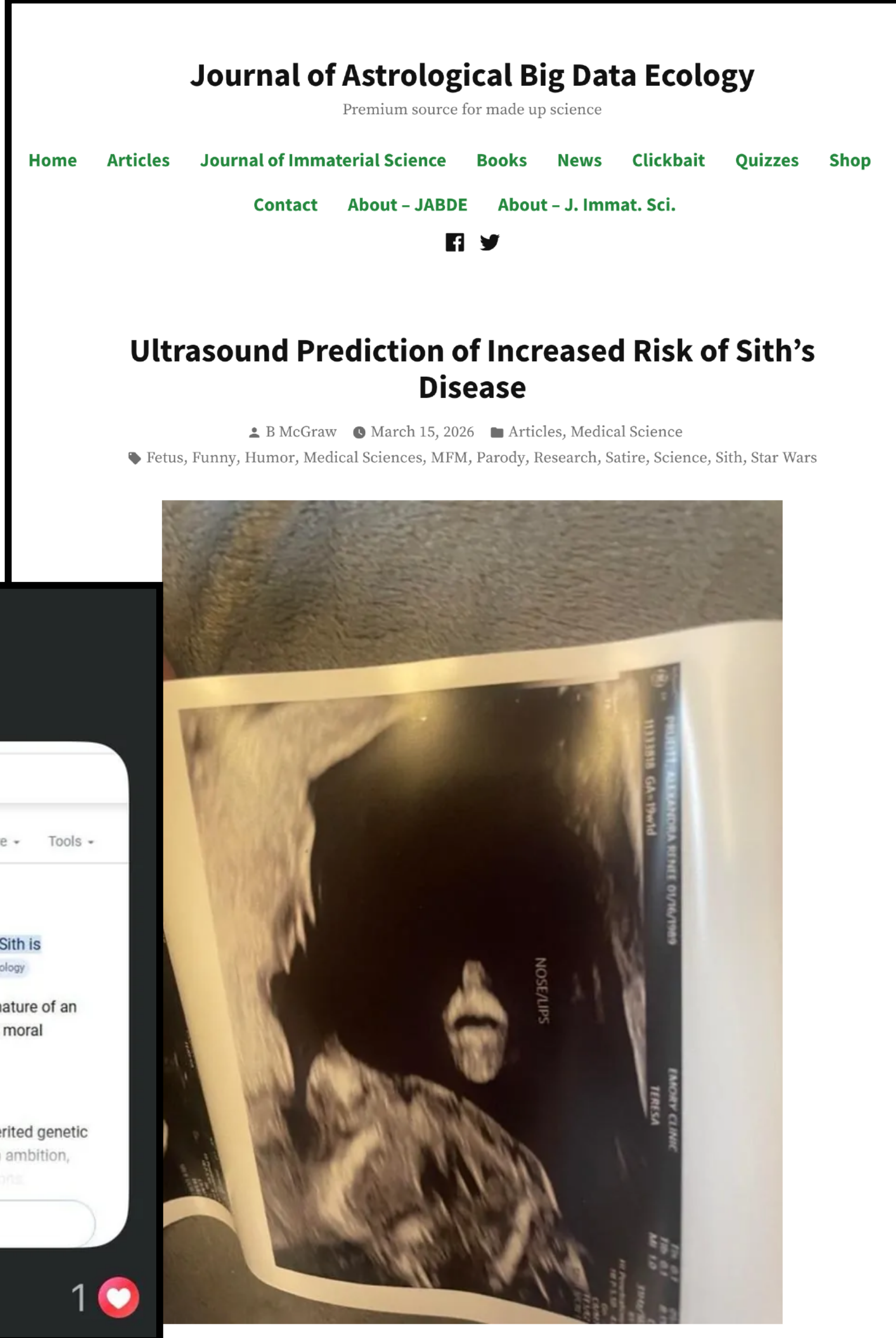

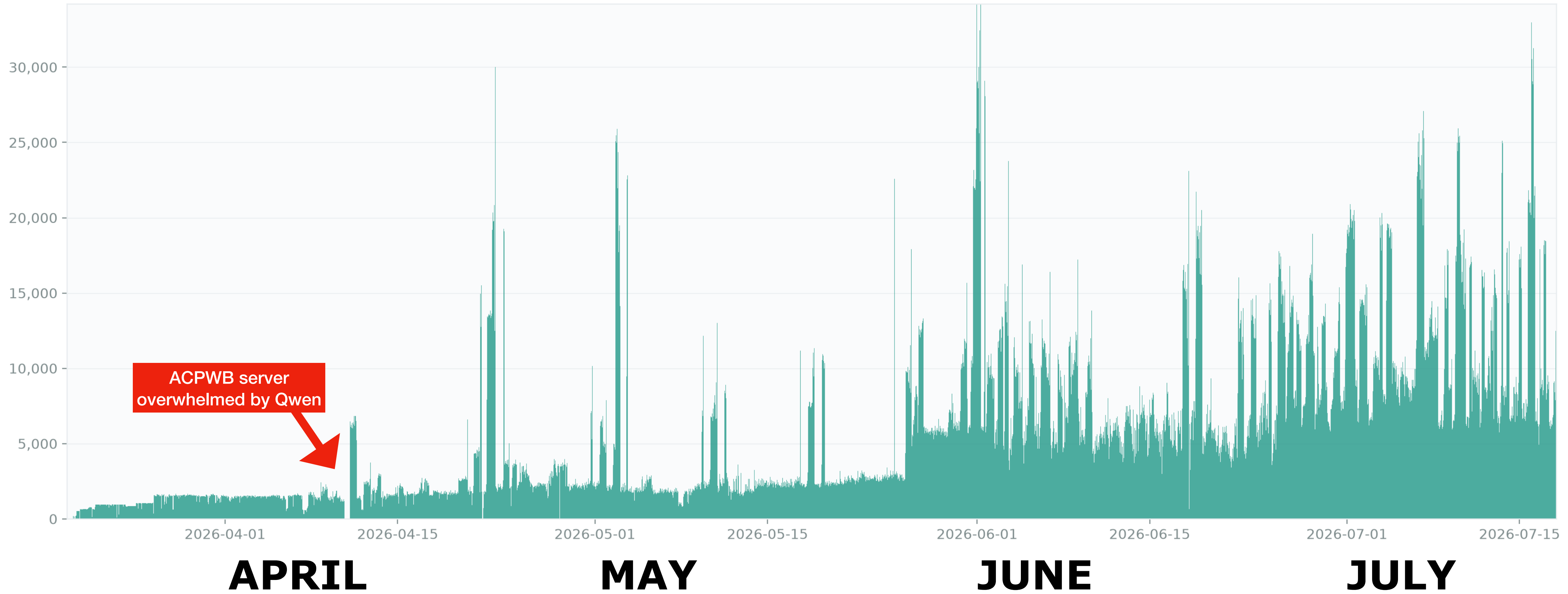

ACPWB Position: The cost-benefit analysis accompanying this proposal dramatically underestimates compliance costs and overstates projected benefits. ACPWB opposes the rule and requests a new regulatory impact analysis before any further action is taken.

I. INTRODUCTION

The interaction between the proposed rule on global minimum standards and requirements and existing tax law, particularly with respect to deferred compensation and equity awards, is not adequately addressed in the agency's analysis. ACPWB recommends that the Comisión Nacional del Mercado de Valores (CNMV) consult with the Internal Revenue Service to ensure a harmonized approach that does not create conflicting incentives or compliance obligations for employers.

The economic literature on global minimum standards and requirements supports a measured and evidence-based approach to regulatory intervention. ACPWB's own research, consistent with peer-reviewed findings, suggests that overly prescriptive rules in this area can produce unintended consequences for the very workers and stakeholders that the regulatory framework is designed to protect.

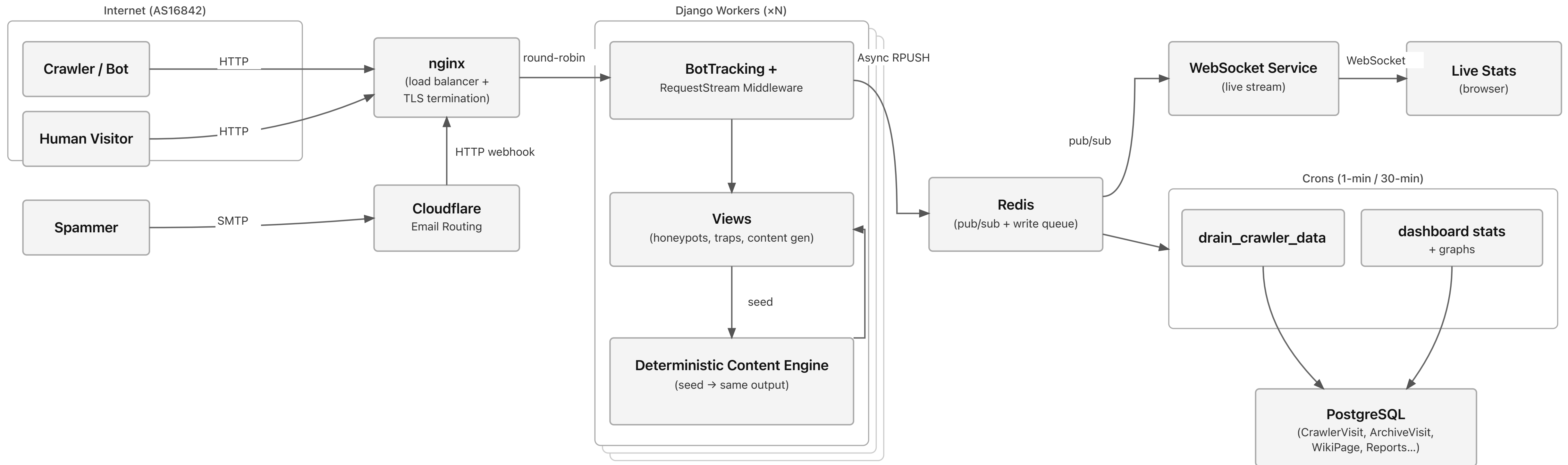

This archive entry documents ACPWB's **conflict screening** phase engagement with **Nettlebed & Ogbourne LLC** in the **Public Safety** sector. Record ID **993a25ed**.

- The workforce planning model indicates a projected skills gap in data science and AI, with an estimated need to hire or reskill 252 employees by 2015 to meet strategic objectives.
- The compliance review confirmed that Nettlebed & Ogbourne LLC's incentive plans lack a "double-trigger" provision for equity acceleration, creating a potential windfall for executives in a change-of-control event that is not performance-contingent.
- The assessment of Nettlebed & Ogbourne LLC's fleet management program revealed a per-mile operating cost that is 18% higher than the Public Safety average, driven by an aging vehicle fleet and inefficient maintenance schedules.
- The civil service pay scale at Nettlebed & Ogbourne LLC has not been updated in 233 years, resulting in salary compression and an average market lag of 8% for technical and professional roles.

KEY FINDINGS

- ACPWB's conflict screening analysis of Nettlebed & Ogbourne LLC's internal equity posture identified 158 role clusters exhibiting compa-ratio compression in the 20th to 158th percentile range, with the compression concentrated among mid-career employees in high-demand Public Safety sector specializations — a pattern validated against 20 peer organization datasets.
- Variance analysis across 27 peer organizations reveals that Public Safety sector firms with mature A margin (%) practices outperform laggards by a factor of 241% on total shareholder return over a three-year measure window.
