Who We Were This Time


- 1236 paid registrations

Document Actions and RFCs since Dallas




- 4 new WGs, 13 WGs closed
 - Approximately 125 WGs currently chartered
- 463 new I-Ds (56% in last 4 weeks)
- 852 updated I-Ds (67 % in last 4 weeks)
- 80 IETF Last Calls
- 96 approvals
- About 138 RFCs published (88 standards/BCP)





Reducing scheduling panic

 - Final agenda October 16




