# Base Spec

- New: draft-ietf-sieve-3028bis-07
- Issues:
  - what does redirect mean in terms of formatting messages? Do we need to be more explicit and compare with 2822 definitions for forward etc?
  - do we want to permit arbitrary octets in strings for e.g. vacation :mime?
    - ignore the problem - not an issue in practice (revert to 3028 ABNF - i.e. NOT utf-8)
    - create new syntax element - but would have to rev. vacation (AUTH48?)
  - IANA - Phil has spoken with them. Adding Description field, combine Keyword and Name. Other extensions will need to be updated (AUTH48 for those in queue).

# Base Spec (comparators)

- Please review it.
- Should be correct as far as SIEVE is concerned now.

# MIME Loops

- Old: draft-ietf-sieve-mime-loop-00
- Sorry - missed the deadline for drafts :-(
- Various issues outstanding:
  - depth of nested for\_every\_part - proposed solution is make it an implementation defined value
  - Test parts: :type, :subtype, :contenttype, :param
  - Allow address and exists tests
  - Proposed syntax:
    - header :mime
    - address :mime
    - exists :mime

# Regex

- Old: draft-ietf-sieve-regex-00
- This has been dragging on for a long time.
- Are people still interested in working on this or should we drop it (can become individual submission)?

# Reject/Refuse

- New: draft-ietf-sieve-refuse-reject-02
- Issues:
  - SHOULD it be incompatible with other actions? e.g. reject + fileinto allowed?
    - Explicitly list incompatible actions (which ones?)
    - Add explanatory text as to why there is incompatibility
    - Runtime error or reject wins?
  - Non-ascii text in reject string?
    - Strip UTF-8 from string
    - Send DSN instead
    - Don't send custom string (send either implementation defined string or none at all)
    - Runtime error (not an option)

# Notification

- New: draft-ietf-sieve-notify-03
- New: draft-ietf-sieve-notify-xmpp-01
- Issues:
  - Rename :priority to :importance
  - Change :options to be multiple ‘:option string string/number’?
  - What is the initial list of :options? IANA registry?
  - Method registry? (Can include options)
  - OK to have normative references to JEP (Jabber Extension Proposal)?

# Date

- New: draft-freed-sieve-date-index-01
- Question on using Index for header and address tests
  - what is real utility of this?
- Ready for last call.

# ManageSIEVE

- Old: draft-martin-managesieve-06
- Wait on lemonade to decide what to do?
- Interaction with include (next topic)...

# Include

- New: draft-daboo-sieve-include-05
- Added new import/export mechanism to cope with interaction with variables.
- Still some debate as to whether this is the right approach for variables.
- Interaction with ManageSIEVE?
  - Order of upload
  - ‘Atomic’ commits of script groups.
