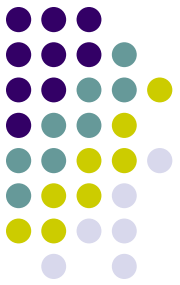
Issues

- ObservationDomain → ObservationPointGroup
 - To accommodate the fact that information can come from more than one Observation Point
- Inactive/ActiveTimeout does not fit to Template
 - Create a new Table – ipfixMeteringProcessTable
 - Table contains a list of caches
 - Template linked to a cache

Changes in the MIB Structure



- Changes to the overall structure
 - Substituted Observation Domain Table with Observation Point Table and Observation Point Group Table
 - Added Metering Process Table
 - Moved inactive and active timeout to that table
- Improved Descriptions and Text
 - Integrated comments/suggestions received from reviews
