### General status

- Version 4 of draft released June 2009
- We hope to LC soon after Stockholm
- We hope to get approval for publication before Hiroshima
  - Free the other 3 docs from the RFC editor queue

## Update since Version 2

- Feedback since Version 2 from Evangelos and Joel
  - We have added clarity to scheduling
  - We have dropped TLS from the security section
    - There are some elements of TLS+SCTP which are not standardized yet
      - Discussed in SF
  - We have moved the non-normative text on scheduling etc to the appendices

## Update since Interop

- We found we had one extra PL priority not used
  - We want to reserve one priority
  - Poll: Should we reserve highest or lowest prio?
- Draft "recommends" priority range for PL messages
  - Original intent was to leave it upto implementation
  - This caused a little bit of a chaos as every implementation interpreted it their way
    - Feedback from Chuanhuang Li
      - We are going to enforce (MUST) PL
        mapping of messages priority, and channel

## Update since Interop

- Talked to SCTP core people (Michael Tuxen et al)
  - We need to ask for 3 SCTP PPID from IANA
