# Status

- BCP vs. Informational
  - will add some text explaining there is an intent to go to BCP at a later stage, and the RFC 2119 language is not a concern
- identityref vs. enumeration
  - will add text that if the enum values are just the current values of a (possibly) growing set of values, then use identityref instead

# Open Issues

- temporary namespace URI while work-in-progress
  - suggest “file://module-name.yang”
  - prefer not to leave this field invalid like in SMIv2
- number of top-level elements in a module
  - should there be any recommendation at all?
  - if so, should the number be 1?
- mandatory-stmt or non-zero min-elements-stmt for top-level objects
  - this is not really deployable because it immediately causes the running configuration to become invalid
  - should this condition be a MUST NOT, SHOULD NOT, or just a warning in this I-D?
  - Or, should this condition be an error in the YANG I-D?
