Recommended Query Frequency

- ❑ Previous versions of the document recommended that relying parties query the repository system for new data at least once a day
- ❑ The authors received feedback that one query per day would imply that the maximum time to fix a problem could be unacceptably large
- ❑ SIDR-arch-09 recommends much more frequent queries by relying parties
- ❑ Significant list discussion ensued
 - Trade offs between repository server loads versus time to propagate updates to relying parties

Recommended Query Frequency

□ Recommendation:

- The architecture document is revised to remove any recommendations regarding the frequency with which relying parties query the repository system
- The working group may choose to make a recommendation in a subsequent document (e.g., an operational considerations document)
