---

# Location Conveyance

---

- New revision available at -01 deadline.
- New document is a radical simplification that cuts the length of the document in approximately half.

# Re-INVITE

---

- Some recent discussion on-list, conclusion of that conversation have been addressed.
- Author working with AD to resolve final set of issues before IESG evaluation.

# Example Security Flows
