Why Revise?

- Evolution
 - Some existing common practices should be recognized
 - Suffixes, created for XML, have been more generally used and useful
 - Fragments
- Concerns that process was difficult enough to discourage registrations

Major Changes

- New “structured syntax” (suffix) procedure
- Registration template modified to include fragment/anchor identifiers
- Streamline standards tree registration – expert review
- Recognize reality for widely-deployed unregistered types
