Q1

Q1: Answers

- MAP is ONE Solution -> (Do Q2 and Q3)
- MAP is really TWO Solutions (MAP-E and MAP-T) -> (Do Q2 and Q4)

Q2

- Q2: MAP-T will not preserve the DF bit in IPv4 packets in one specific case (DF=1, MF=1) and may cause IPv4 Packetization Layer Path MTU Discovery to not work properly (Issue #8)
 - Is this important?
