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Open Issues

- Issue 4: Untrusted location and provider intent
 - Role of “location-based services”
- Issue 8: Solutions
 - The document should include solutions and recommendations.
- Issue 9: Definition of “trustworthy”
 - In practice, the ability to hold prank callers accountable is as (or more) important than location accuracy.
- Issue 10: Section 5
 - Section 5 (Operational Considerations) needs to be re-organized to more clearly relate to Solutions (Section 4) or Security Considerations (Section 6).



Issue status

- Issue 4: Untrusted location and provider intent
 - Proposal is to address this issue in Section 2 (added in -04).
- Issue 8: Solutions
 - Changed in -02: Section 4 lays out the major approaches: location-by-reference, proxy adding location and location signing.
 - Still needed: evaluation of the solutions against the threats. Proposal is to add this material to Section 4.
- Issue 9: Definition of “trustworthy”
 - Changed in -04: Section 1 and 6 now includes a mention o the importance of audit.
 - Still needed: addressing arguments that “based on client information” == “untrustworthy”. Proposal is to add this material to Section 2 (as part of an expanded discussion of the IETF location architecture).
- Issue 10: Section 5
 - Proposal to come.
