Presentation of Aggregated Service Discovery

- Configure clients with minimal user input.
- Configure clients for multiple services.
- Support most client types (mobile, browser, etc.).
- Minimize barriers to deployment and adoption.

- What are the specific target use cases?
- Is this service discovery or client configuration?
- How is this different from IMSP or ACAP?
- Why not just use WebFinger?
- Many other good questions raised.
