Motivation

- Document deployed GRE Fragmentation Strategy
 - Implementers are aware of BCP
 - Users understand how implementations work
- Scope
 - Point-to-point GRE Only
 - Does not update [RFC2784]

Default Fragmentation Strategy

- GRE Ingress do not fragment the delivery header:
 - Received non-fragmentable big packet -> signal to the source
 - Received fragmentable big packet -> fragment the inner packet
- On IPv4 delivery header, always DF=1
- Use when network does not block ICMPs, and payload and tunnel source support PMTUD.

Non-Default Fragmentation Strategy

- On IPv4 delivery header, copy DF from the inner packet
- Use when network blocks ICMPs
