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# FedFS Document Status

## Existing documents

- Two documents in RFC Editor queue:
  - “Administration Protocol for Federated Filesystems”
  - “NSDB Protocol for Federated Filesystems”
- Both await completion of RFC 3530bis

# FedFS Document Status

## New document

- Security update requested
  - Define GSSAPI service name for ADMIN protocol
  - Describe how to fence an NSDB
- Submitted document to address security issues
  - draft-cel-nfsv4-fedfs-security-addendum-00 (July 11)
  - Depends on completion of ADMIN and NSDB documents

# FedFS Future Work

## In Progress

- Multi-domain authentication
  - Best practices
- SMB support
  - NSDB schema updates
  - FedFS and Samba junction co-existence

# FedFS Future Work

## Possible new work

- Pre-populating /nfs4
  - But avoiding the 'ls /afs' problem
- Improve use of LDAP
  - New SASL/GSSAPI NSDB connection security mode
    - Same password for ADMIN and NSDB
  - Replace namingContext updates with LDAP search
  - LDAP referrals and update referrals best practices
  - Integrated certificate management (e.g. OCSP)
  - NSDB discovery for admin tools

# FedFS Future Work

## Possible new work

- New ADMIN operations
  - Remove NSDB connection parameters
  - Fence NSDBs
  - List NSDBs known to a fileserver
  - Flesh out FEDFS\_CREATE\_REPLICATION and friends
  - Common junction administrative interface
    - FedFS
    - NFS
    - Samba

# FedFS Future Work

## Possible new work


- Not all locations are reachable by every client
  - Non-routeable addresses, like IPv6 link local
  - Fileservers can reside in DMZs
  - Multi-homed servers
- Clients must be quick to select a working location
- fs\_locations\_info doesn't help NFSv4.0 clients
- Fileservers can sort the locations heuristically

## Avoid modifying root suffix entries

- Each root suffix entry superior to an NSDB Container Entry are configured with
  - Object class “fedfsNsdbContainerInfo”
  - Attribute fedfsNceDn, whose value is the full DN of the NCE

# Appendix

## Avoid modifying root suffix entries

- Practical objections to this mechanism
  - Altering root suffix entries may not be permitted
  - Altering root suffix entries is done differently for each LDAP server implementation
  - An LDAP search works just as well

# Appendix

## Avoid modifying root suffix entries

- Let's replace this mechanism
- For each root suffix on an NSDB
  - Client performs a subtree search with filter '&(objectclass=fedfsNsdbContainerInfo)'
  - Distinguished Name of the NCE under that namingContext is part of server's response
