

# Manifest EE Certificate Validity Times

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# Proposed Change to RFC 6486

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In the case of a "one-time-use" EE certificate, the validity times of the EE certificate MUST exactly match the thisUpdate and nextUpdate times of the manifest.

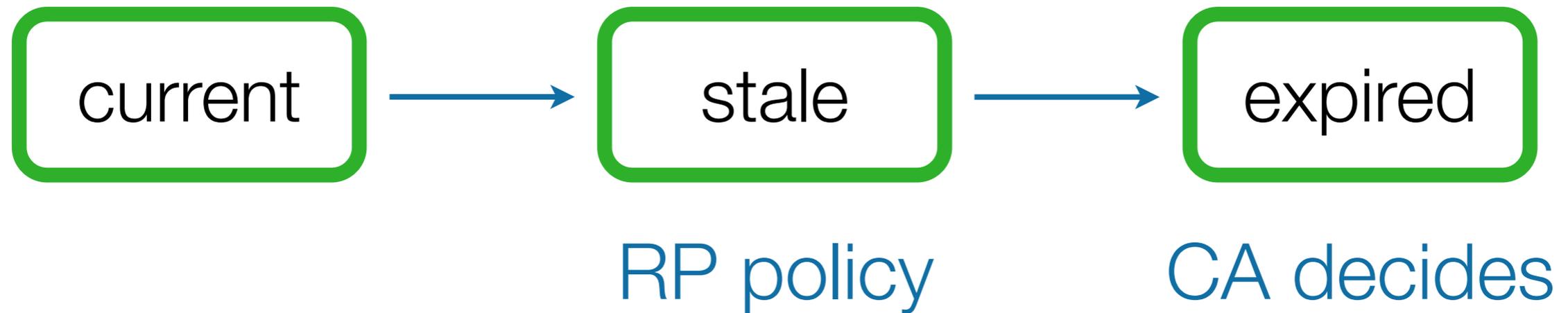
In the case of a "sequential-use" EE certificate, the validity times of the EE certificate MUST encompass the time interval from thisUpdate to nextUpdate



The validity times of the EE certificate MUST encompass the time interval from thisUpdate to nextUpdate.

# Rationale

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- Let RP use local policy to deal with failure to retrieve updates, regardless of cause
- Let CAs ‘fiddle’ with soft limits: “we will most likely republish by..., but please don’t reject everything if we’re late, or.. you are.”, and hard limits: “reject everything that’s expired, I am not willing to risk my data replayed after this much time ”.
- Arguments against?
