Introduction

- RFC5512 (draft-ietf-softwire-encaps-safi) specifies a method by which BGP speakers can signal tunnel encapsulation information (e.g., encapsulation type) to each other and accordingly it defines support for:
 - GRE
 - L2TPv3
 - IP-in-IP
- MPLS-in-UDP (draft-ietf-mpls-in-udp) has been adopted by the MPLS
 WG as a WG doc. Hence this document builds on RFC5512 and defines support for this new encapsulation type:
 - A new BGP Tunnel Type code (TBD) indicating the UDP tunnel type is required to be assigned by IANA.
