- General bug fixing.,
- Added [Section 1.7](#). on Configuration and Monitoring Functionality Levels,
- Changed diverse occurrences of "networks" to "networks with/of constrained devices",
- Introduced the term "Self-configuring infrastructure-less networks" as a superset of MANET,
- Introduced the term 'sleepy endpoints',
- Changed requirement IDs to be independent of section number,
- Introduced notes for parts of the requirements text if it is focusing on implementation or solution,
- Extended Security Considerations section (needs an alignment with use cases draft),
- Deleted [Appendix A](#) and B on other SDO's work and related projects as they provide dynamic information and cannot be kept up-to-date.

# draft-ietf-opsawg-coman-use-cases-01

- Reordered some use cases to improve the flow.
- Added use case on "Vehicular Networks".
- Shortened the Military Operations use case.
- Improved the security considerations section.
  
- Open issues:
  - [Section 3.11](#) should be replaced by a different use case motivating similar requirements or perhaps deleted if the IETF prefers to not work on specific requirements coming from military use cases.
  - [Section 3.8](#) and [Section 3.9](#) could be merged.
