## Changes between '02' & '03' (1)

Addressed comments from Kevin's review.

- 'processed' status
  - Indicates that a trigger has been accepted, but the uCDN will not provide further status updates.
  - To remove confusion around using status 'complete' with an estimated completion time in the future.
  - 'processed' triggers are included in the collection of 'complete' triggers.

## Changes between '02' & '03' (2)

- Simplified collections
  - Replaced the typed 'Relationship' objects in '\_links' introduced in '-02' with a list of URLs.
- Auto-deletion of trigger status after "at least 24h".
  - Rather than "at 24h".
- Tidied up some normative language.
  - But there's more to do (Francois' comments).
- 'Security Considerations' rewritten
  - Based on the text in the Logging draft, esp requirements for TLS support.

## Next steps

- Kevin's comment ...
  - Do we need to separate cancellation of a trigger from deletion of the trigger status resource (to make it possible to report status of a cancelled trigger).
- Address comments from Francois ...
  - Normative language and several clarifications.
