#### draft-ietf-l3vpn-pmsi-registry

- Short and straightforward to create an IANA registry for RFC6514 PMSI Tunnel Attribute types
- Quickly written and reviewed to accelerate the progress of draft-ietf-mpls-seamless-mcast



#### draft-ietf-l3vpn-mvpn-bidir

- Draft has been adopted in 2011
- Draft went through WG last call two months ago
- We later asked about IPR disclosure having been made
  - (when we noticed that it had not been done at adoption time, back in 2011)
- Ice Wijnands notified us July 3<sup>rd</sup> about not yet disclosed IPR that ought to have been disclosed earlier as per rules in BCP79
- The document will have to go back to the WG to offer the opportunity for people to comment
- Take away: please read the Note Well, and take action to conform. We will ask to you, authors, to confirm that IPR has been properly disclosed, but you are expected to act before we ask.

#### draft-ietf-l3vpn-end-system

- Draft went through WG last call a few month ago
- Specifications have a normative dependency on specifications for XMPP publish/subscribe "collection nodes" (XEP-0248 of the XMPP Standard Foundation)
- We noticed during shepherd review that XEP-0248 status is "Deferred", and learned with XMPP standard foundation folks, that XEP-0248 is "nowhere near ready to serve as a normative reference"
- Authors confirmed the feasibility to rewrite the specs to rely instead on XEP-0060 (XMPP base publish/subscribe specifications)
- The draft is back to the working group and waiting for this update
