Functional description of anchors

- ◆ Functions of an anchor common to the different solutions:
- ◆ (1) advertise prefix/address of the MN
- ◆ (2) allocate prefix/address of the MN

Functional description of anchors

- ◆ Functions not common to all the solutions:
- ◆ (1) packets to/from the MN traverse through.
- ◆ (2) indirection, e.g., tunneling
- ◆ (3) information, e.g., binding HoA and CoA
- ◆ (4) sends route update, e.g., using BGP

- ◆ Methods to provide mobility support using anchor:
- ◆ (1) indirection
- ◆ (2) update routing tables
