# Purpose of draft (1)

- Specify IETF mechanisms to enable next generation (all-IP) pan-European eCall
- eCall is a standardized vehicle emergency call system providing voice and vehicle data (called Minimum Set of Data or MSD) mandated in the European Union

# Purpose of Draft (2)

- Describes how the pan-European eCall service can be supported using IETF standards (adhering to European Commission requirements and regulations)
- Required by ETSI report on eCall migration: "ETSI Mobile Standards Group (MSG); eCall for VoIP", TR 103 140 4/2014
- Anticipated requirements by 3GPP eCall work

# Draft Status

- Draft was split off from draft-rosen-ecrit-ecall (which had 11 versions)
- This draft is for pan-European eCall
- Sixth revision since split
- Reworded text, added details, etc.
