- add a new value for the cause that it can be possible to tag a service access number anywhere in the signaling path.

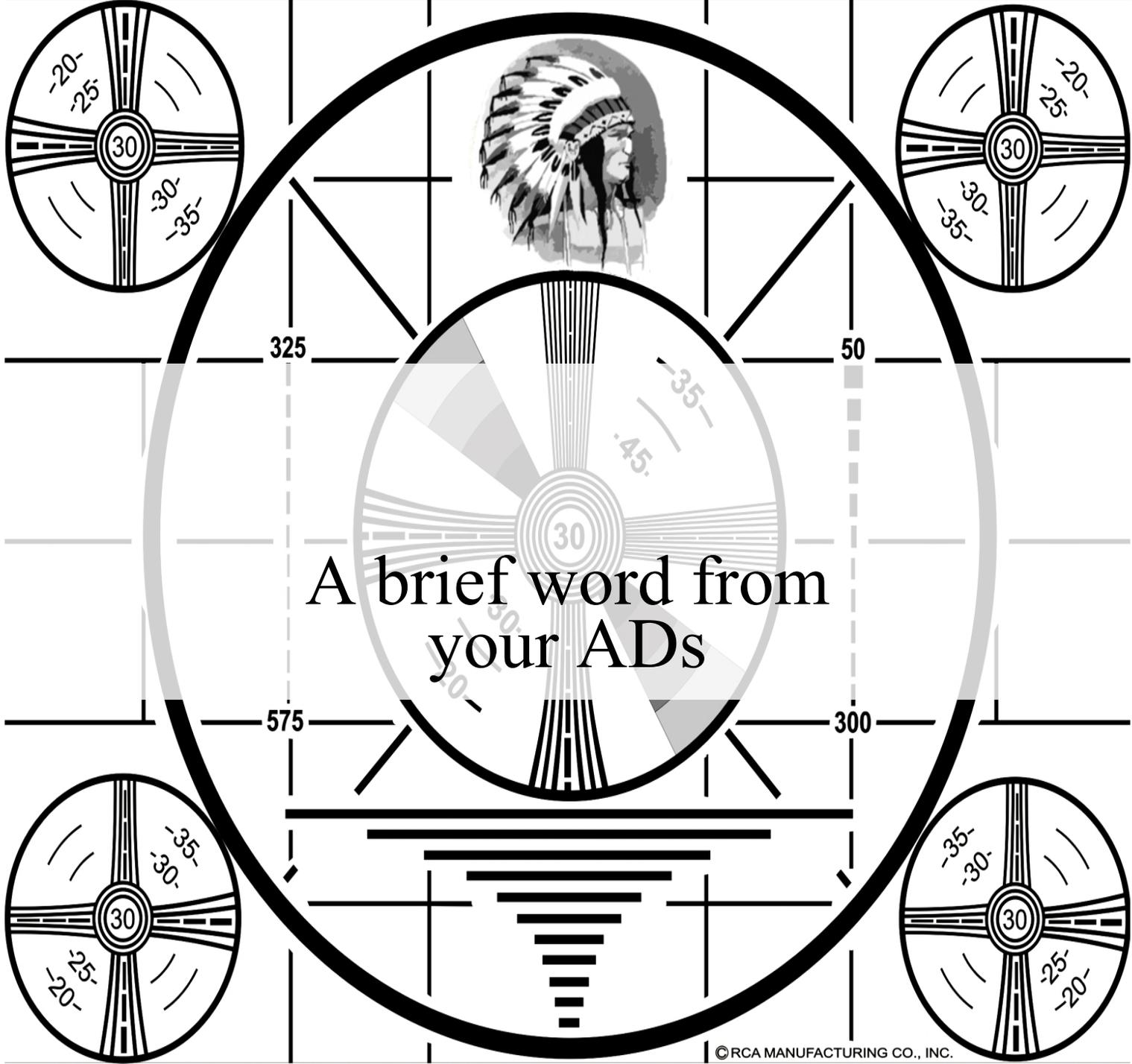

SIP Forum - IP-NNI Initiative

task force to develop IP-NNI (Network-to-Network Interface) voluntary, consensus-driven specifications for North American Service Providers.

- Identify a baseline set of features that should be common to all IP-NNI implementations for voice service.
- Two draft specifications for public review/feedback:
 - (1) IP Interconnection Profile (what goes on the wire)
 - (2) IP Interconnection Routing Report (Number Translation and the databases/non normative)
