Proposal for new ICE WG

- ICE developed in MMUSIC for past ~12 years
 - ICE draft adopted October 2003
 - RFC 5245 published 2010
 - ICE TCP published 2012
- Past few years lots of ICE activity
 - Largely due to WebRTC/RTCWEB
 - About half of MMUSIC cycles spent on this
 - 5 WG documents at the moment

Proposal for new ICE WG

- Idea: Split ICE work into a new WG:
 - Focus only on ICE
 - ICE-specific SDP changes in that group as well
 - More general SDP extensions to be handled in MMUSIC
 - Similar to other WGs defining new SDP attributes
- New mailing list for discussion: ice@ietf.org
 - First charter proposal discussed
