- NETCONF Call Home had a 2nd and successful WG LC.
  - Will go to AD review
- Server Model and RESTCONF Package (including YANG Patch and YANG Library) will go to WG LC after this meeting
  - Server Model: All issues solved or in review
  - RESTCONF: 2 new issues
  - YANG Patch: 1 open issue
  - YANG Library: 1 open issue
- Zerotouch: 1 new and 2 open issues
- RESTCONF collection did not have much progress
- draft-mm-netconf-time-capability is in IETF LC until July 29, 2015.
  - Upon request Netconf co-chairs polled the opinion of WG members. There was not much support for adoption.
