Status Since Buenos Aires - Details

In-depth reviews of draft-ietf-netmod-syslog-model-07 and draft-ietf-netmod-syslog-model-08 by Jason Sterne, Tom Petch, and Jüergen Schoenwaelder

Result is the draft-ietf-netmod-syslog-model-09 update:

1. Greater model clarity:
 - a) removed log-input-transports which was added in the 08 update - if this is to be added in the future, it will need additional work.
 - b) removed actions 'terminal' since it was only implemented by one vendor.
 - c) removed 'feature session-facility-user-logging' as a simplification.
 - d) shortened names as a simplification
2. Addressed all editorial comments from Jüergen.
3. Worked with Kent Watsen and Gary Wu to add TLS support in the ietf-syslog yang model as comment lines until the ietf-tls-client.yang module is ready.
