- Document describes a regulatory use case for net neutrality measurements based on the new European open internet regulation.
- The purpose of this document is to give sufficient details for developing the actual net neutrality measurement metrics.

Regulatory use cases:

- » Monitoring the performance of internet access services
- Detecting traffic management practices that impact QoS or reachability of individual applications
- » Detecting end-user dependent factors that may impact the measurement results
